**Fifth Sunday of Lent, March 29, 2020**

Because of the situation with the Coronavirus, bishop Checchio has temporarily suspended all weekday and Sunday public Masses in the presence of the lay faithful in the Diocese of Metuchen until Friday, April 3<sup>rd</sup>. All daily and weekend Masses will be said privately until we receive further communication from the Diocese. Mass intentions will be applied.

Our pastor, Fr. Ryan, writes in his letter to Holy Family Parishioners:  
” We enjoin all to be with us in a spirit of prayer from your home. Perhaps you could set a small prayer table in your home; include a family bible, a cross that has a special significance. Other objects could be a statue of Mary or a rosary. The daily scripture readings and other prayer resources could be found on the computer at [www.usccb.org](http://www.usccb.org) as well as other websites. We hope to offer live streaming so that you can participate in our Sunday worship remotely online in your homes.”

**Polish Mass on Sunday** will be available for viewing on the internet. Daily Mass in English is available at [www.stfranciscathedral.org](http://www.stfranciscathedral.org) at 7 a.m. **Stations of the Cross** and **Mass on Friday** are cancelled.

The schedule for the Holy Week will be as follows (pending Bishop Checchio's approval): **Easter Triduum:**

**Holy Thursday, April 9** – Evening Mass of the Lord's Supper at 9 p.m.; **Good Friday, April 10** – Service of Celebration of the Lord's Passion at 7 p.m.; **Holy Saturday, April 11** – blessing of the food at 10:00, 11:00, and 12:00 (with the Confession in between); The Easter Vigil at 8:00 p.m. at Sacred Heart Church; **Easter Sunday, April 12** – Resurrection Mass with the Procession at 8 a.m. **On Wednesday, April 8, at 6:00 p.m.** we will be cleaning the church in preparation for Easter.

**“I am the resurrection and the life; whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live.” Jn 11:25**

**“If the Spirit of the One who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, that One who raised the Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also.” Rom 8:11**

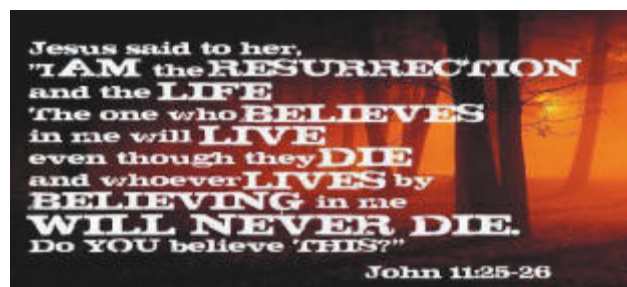
So, “if we live and believe in Jesus Christ we will never die. Do we believe this?” Jn 11:26

Martha answered, “Yes, Lord.” I hope we did too. However, is it our next breath to say, “Lord, if you had been here, my brother would not have died.” Jn 11:32b To have eyes and yet not see, is this not also our shortcoming as was the case with the Pharisees? We must observe life with our spiritual eyes not our physical ones. The eyes of the flesh only see in the flesh, they are concerned only with pleasing the flesh, and judge according to the flesh.

Saint Paul reminds the Romans and us that we must turn away from our sinful nature by recognizing that the sinful deeds that we think and do come from the flesh, “and those who are in the flesh cannot please God.” Rom 8:8 How can we accomplish this? Paul uses himself as an example. “What I do, I do not understand. For I do not do what I want, but [rather] I do what I hate [in myself].” And I recognize this as sin. “So now [I can argue], it is no longer I who do these things, but sin that dwells in me,” that is my flesh. Rom 7:15-20 The principle at war with my mind that delights in the Laws of God is the law of sin that dwells in my flesh. Rom 7:21-25

Therefore according to Saint Paul, the concerns and the yearnings of the flesh are hostile toward God. The flesh does not submit to the Law of God and cannot please God, because the Law of God is spiritual as measured through the Commandments. Hence, it will always be contrary to the flesh. But “if the Spirit of God dwells in you, if Christ is in you, although the body is dead because of sin, the spirit is alive because of righteousness. If the Spirit of the One who raised Jesus from the dead dwells in you, that One who raised the Christ from the dead will give life to your mortal bodies also.” Rom 8:9b-11

The Risen Christ in us, in whose Spirit we want to live and dwell transforms our mortal sinful bodies through His resurrection on the cross to everlasting life. What Easter Joy!
