**MAY- The Month of Mary****PRAYERS TO MARY****1. Hail Mary**

Hail Mary, full of grace. Our Lord is with thee. Blessed art thou among women and blessed is the fruit of thy womb, Jesus. Holy Mary, Mother of God, pray for us sinners, now and at the hour of our death. Amen.

That's one of the most traditional Catholic prayers. Saying this prayer, we ask the Virgin Mary to intercede for us, to pray for us, to give us the strength and the patience to follow Her Child's path. Hail Mary is the fourth bead of a Blessed Rosary's decade.

2. Hail, Holy Queen (Salve Regina)

Hail Holy Queen, Mother of mercy, Our life, our sweetness, and our hope. To thee do we cry, poor banished children of Eve. To thee do we send up our sighs, mourning and weeping in this valley of tears. Turn then, most gracious advocate, thine eyes of mercy towards us. And after this, our exile, show unto us the blessed fruit of thy womb, Jesus. O clement O loving O sweet Virgin Mary.

With the final one of the Rosary's prayers, we admit, confess our sins to Her. But She's full of grace, so She will dispense that grace above us, and help us asking for God's forgiveness.

3. Memorare

Remember, o most gracious Virgin Mary, that never was it known that anyone who fled to thy protection, implored thy help, or sought thy intercession was left unaided. Inspired with this confidence, I fly to thee, O Virgin of virgins, my Mother; to thee do I come; before thee I stand, sinful and sorrowful. O Mother of the Word Incarnate, despise not my petitions, but in thy mercy hear and answer me. Amen.

All we need Virgin Mary's assistance. She leads us through this valley of tears, She's always by our side. The Memorare prayer remembers us that, in the journey of life, we're not alone. That the mother of our Lord, the Blessed Virgin Mary, protects us.


