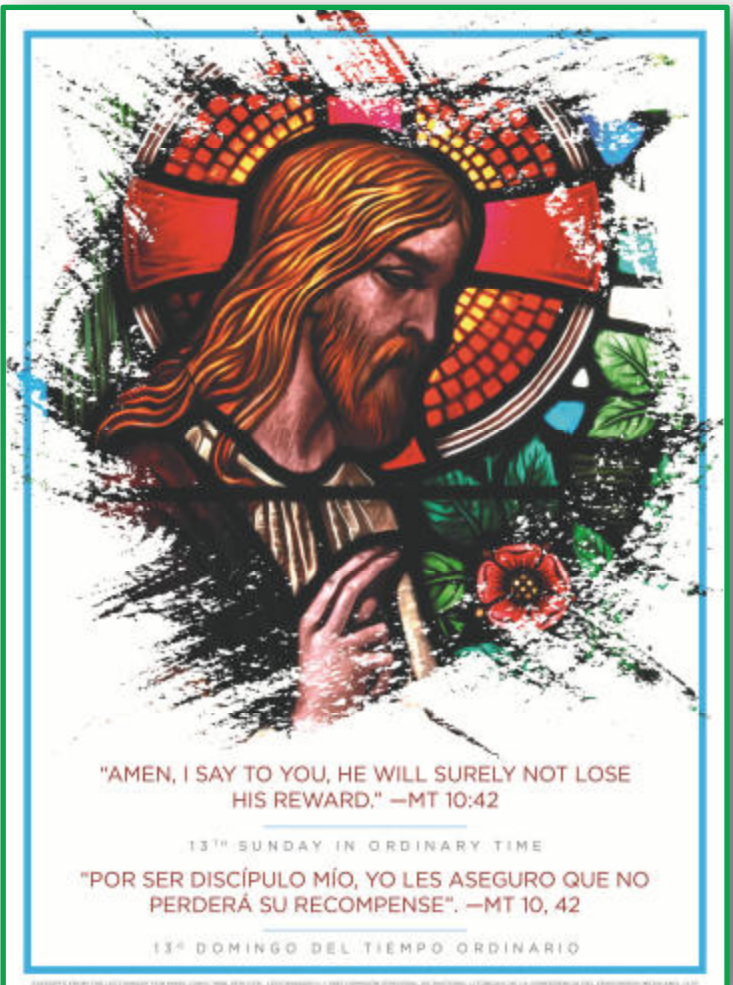

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

As Catholics, we have many sacred traditions. An example is the blessing of religious items. One of the religious items that is frequently presented to a priest for a blessing is a cross. Often, these crosses that will be presented to family members to place in a home or even wear as a necklace. Wearing a necklace of the cross identifies us as a follower of Jesus.

*A Sunday Reflection

“Whoever [receives his reward on earth and] finds his life [here] will lose it, and whoever [gives up and] loses his [earthly] life for my sake will find it.” Mt 10:39

Are our earthly goals truly right with God?!

When we wish or pray for earthly possessions such as big beautiful houses and cars and things; when we wish and pray for comfort and enjoyment of living; and when we wish and pray for no concerns or hardships are these things truly what God wants of us? Mt 6:5-8

It is not the same to celebrate ourselves, as it is to celebrate ours and others’ accomplishments and happiness. When we ask for earthly things and rewards, it should be for our or others’ whole person, body and soul. “Living a good life” should not mean:

To party all the time, to “live large” or to live for the present, when we must give an accounting of our actions;
A reckless or selfish pursuit of adventure for ourselves in nature, work or sport, when that preoccupation consumes our energy without sacrificing anything for others’ souls;
Simply to satisfy by carnal means our needs and wants constantly without the purpose of benefiting others to some spiritual end.

We should keep our Lenten promises including our attitudes and prayers and sacrifices throughout the year whenever possible so that we may grow in our faith, not just maintain it. If we use the lawn as an analogy of our faith, then we need to maintain it from weeds and pests throughout the year. We also have to be prepared for droughts and severe conditions that might cause adverse conditions to spiral out of control. So, “weed and feed” your faith through the summer months and into the winter, and if you are planning any yard activities, be sure to observe it up close whether it is flourishing or not. Have a nice summer.
