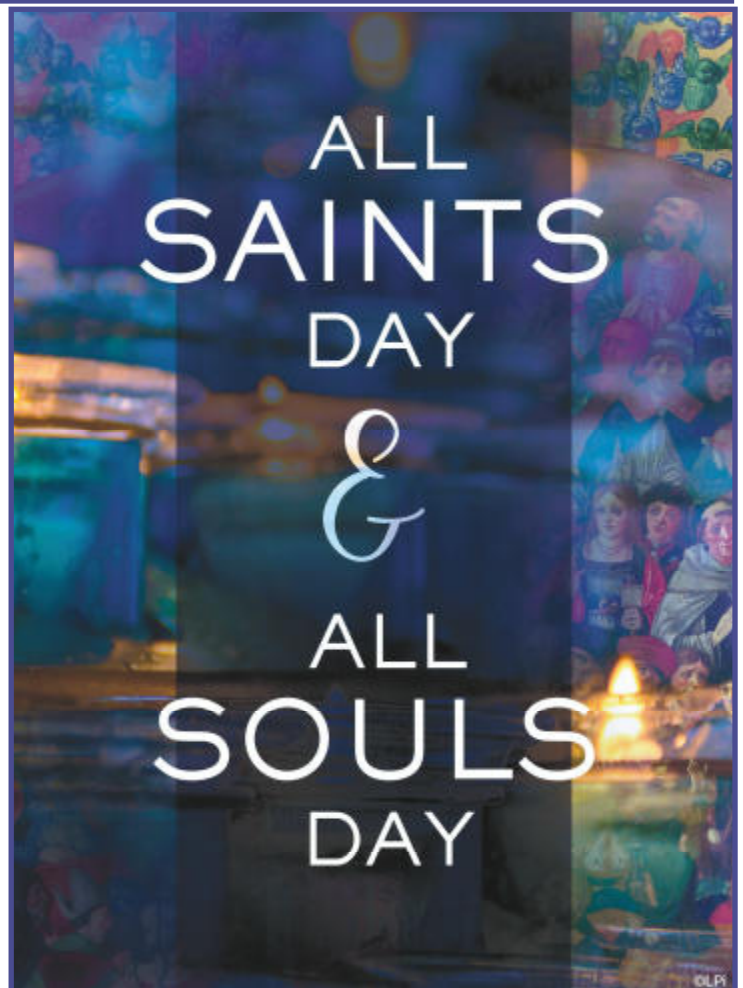

Today's **second collection** will be for **The Society of St. Vincent De Paul**.



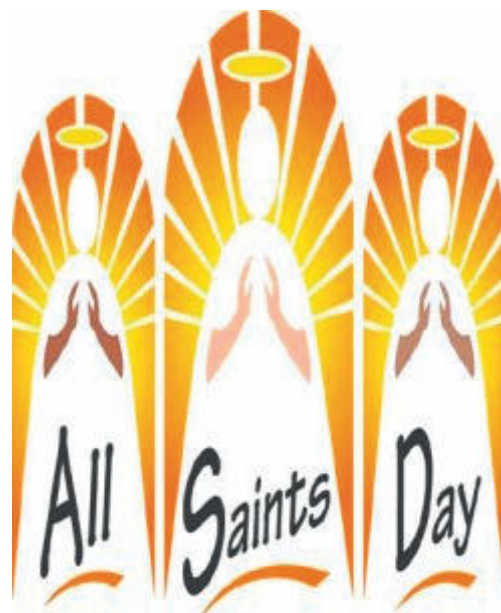

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth*

John's Revelation Chapter 7 depicts a vision of Heaven and of the Glorified Lord and His disciples, as the Tribes of Israel contribute to those marked with the sign of the Lamb: 144 thousand; and among all the nations and peoples of the world, an innumerable throng, "a great multitude" in white robes that have been washed such in the blood of the Lamb.

So we too, act to please God with our service to His Kingdom on Earth and take example from His saints, as to be marked with the sign of the Lamb. The sign of the Lamb is summarized by Jesus in His Sermon on the Mount: firstly, through The Beatitudes; secondly, through the complement to the Commandments and the Mosaic Law He declares; and thirdly, through the action of prayer and charity in exercising self-control. Matthew Chapters 5-7

"See what love the Father has bestowed on us that we may be called children of God. Everyone who has this hope based on Him makes himself pure, as He is pure [, perfect as He is perfect]." 1Jn 3:1a,3
