

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

The final days of our preparation for the celebration of Christmas are quickly passing. These were the days that Mary and Joseph would have been on their journey from Nazareth to Bethlehem. The gospels indicate a long journey, four to seven days. The strong faith of Mary and Joseph give us hope and strength.

Two important people we recall during our advent season are Mary and Joseph. God prepared Mary from the first moment of her conception to become the mother of His only Son. Years later the angel Gabriel announced the mystery of the birth of Jesus to Mary. The words of the angel to Joseph in a dream that Mary would bear a son by the power of the Holy Spirit. The angel went onto to say that Joseph himself would name him Jesus.

On December 8, 1870, Pope Pius IX declared St. Joseph as the Patron of the Catholic Church. In honor of the 150th Anniversary of this historic event, Pope Francis has declared a Year of St. Joseph. The dates are December 8, 2020- December 8, 2021.

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth*

**“Behold, I am the handmaid of the Lord.
May it be done unto me according to thy word.” Lk 1:38**

We recite these words in the Angelus. We hail Mary with such fondness for her sacrifice to humanity. A pure vessel chosen by God, born to Saint Anne by divine conception and protected by Jesus, the Son of God, from blemish of sin before the creation of the world. The Immaculate Conception brings forth the Divine Son to be an example to man, that God is truly with us in our humanity.

“And the Word became flesh and made dwelling among us. Jn 1:14

If we are amazed and elated, awestruck and baffled by what we have no control over, such as the birth of a child, then trying to wrap our minds around Jesus' birth is absolutely supernatural. And that is the point! Everything is and should be a wonder to us in its coming to life in this world. From the buds on a tree branch to flowers blooming and seeds germinating, all should be a wonder. How the seasons turn and the wild animals, insects and nature itself changes and yet remains the same, how the earth moves in the heavens along with all the other heavenly bodies and how man alone of all creation has been granted access to the Creator; all this should be a wonder to us. It is not necessary to know how these physical wonders work or came about in order to praise Him. It is only necessary to know, love and serve Him, who has made this world possible for us to dwell in.

We spend so much of our lives trying to learn and decipher the mysteries of the world and universe, when in reality these facts benefit us and the lives of others quite insignificantly. In fact, all or gadgets and discoveries clearly make our lives more complex and difficult, creating endless laws that govern their use and force man-made ideals onto society that can't be achieved. The result is a culture of slaves to inanimate objects. God has already given man everything he needs to function and form the world in which he lives. Instead of accepting this knowledge, we try to make our own version just to realize it was here all along.

If we truly want to know the secret of life, let us follow Him, Our Lord Jesus Christ to His dwelling, as the disciples did (Jn 1:39), by imitating Him in words and actions. He so loved us, that he made His dwelling among us to appease our curiosity and inquisitiveness in this world of wonders. Let us love Him back with the same fervor and passion as He has shown us, and for that, we have been promised a dwelling with Him of joy in eternal paradise.

The annual *Misa de Gallo at St Ladislaus*, has been canceled this year due to the Pandemic. The nine-day celebration of 5 am Masses, sponsored by the Filipino community, usually runs from December 16 to December 24. It designed to honor the Virgin Mary & spiritually prepare for Christmas. It would have been the 7th year in 2020.


