

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

I can't stop thinking about the speech that we hear in today's first reading. This speech was given some time after the resurrection of Jesus. I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you, I will come back again and take you with me, so that where I am you may also be. Where I am going you know the way.’ Thomas [like us] said to Him, ‘Master, we do not know where you are going; how can we know the way?’ Jesus said to him, ‘I am the way, the truth and the life. No one comes to the Father except through me. If you know me, then you will also know my Father. From now on you do know Him and have seen Him. Whoever has seen me has seen the Father. And whatever you ask in my *name*, I will do, so that the Father may be glorified in the Son.’” Jn 14:1-7,9b,13

“If you love me, you will keep my Commandments. Whoever has my Commandments and observes them is the one who loves me.
