A Sunday Reflection

Love thy neighbor Sunday.

As we remember Jesus' words to His Apostles in the Last Supper Discourse of **John 15:9-17** we find the true understanding of how God loves His son, and through the Son all of mankind. "If you keep my commandments, you will remain in my love, just as I have kept my Father's commandments and remain in His love" Jn 15:10

On first reading, we might only glean the obvious that God (or the Son) wishes us to keep His Commandments, the Law He gave to Moses on Mount Sinai, as a sign of our love for Him. However, what is missing from this picture is the unseen meaning commandments should connote to Christians. When Jesus presents this example to His disciples, He actually means we are to subordinate our wants and desires for others needs ("You shall love thy neighbor as thyself." Mt 22:39). It means that by loving God and staying obedient to His Commandments we learn to love our neighbor as a friend, sacrificing for and possibly suffering for their sake as repentance for our soul. Phil 1:29, 2:3 This does not mean we become a slave to others, but rather that we offer up ourselves in work and good deeds that comes with suffering and sacrifice to Christ. Suffering with Christ for their souls gains us the salvation He promised in the joy of knowing a soul has been saved.

Here is the deeper meaning Jesus wishes to emphasize: If you love your brother, you find opportunities to please them by offering to help with their duties when you see them in need or if they ask. So, a true friendship is a mutual love for the other that is expressed by charity of time and work as a sign of respect not only duty. A loving marriage is an example of this. We can also show respect to our friend by accepting their commands without prejudice for how much time, trouble or work it might cost us. Moreover, we drop what we are doing or working and are ready to serve the needs of those we love. In this regard, obedience and service can be considered charity of love. It is the humility of love that humbles us to others' needs, and commands aside our wants for their sake. Phil 2:3-4 Therefore, commandments that we execute for the sake of Christ though revealed in our brethren are commandments of God. "Because love is of God; everyone who loves [for the sake of God] is begotten by God and knows God. In this way was the love of God revealed to us: God sent His only Son into the world so that we might have life through Him." 1Jn 4:7,9
