Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy family Parish,

The great journey of Elijah to Mt. Horeb took forty days walking through the dessert. Before he began, he was distraught and full of fatigue. He actually said "This is enough O Lord! Take my life." We read how an angel from God ordered him to get up and eat. God supplied him with a hearth cake and a jug of water for his journey. He was strengthened by that food and was able to accomplish the forty day journey to Mt. Horeb.

Our journey is the pilgrimage of life. While Elijah journeys to Horeb (or Sinai), a place of encounter with God, our journey is to heaven. On that journey we need to be fed by the Word of God who is Jesus, the Bread of Life. Jesus in both word and sacrament is our food for the journey. We are offered the greatest nourishment by Jesus for this journey.

In our gospel this weekend we are once again reminded that Jesus is the Bread of Life. Our reception of the Eucharist strengthens us. *A Sunday Reflection

August 8, 2021*

**“The Jews murmured about him, because He said, ‘I am the bread that came down from Heaven.’” Jn 6:41**

Why is our problem always with the messenger, who delivers the bad news and not the news itself? How does this make sense? What does the message have to do with who delivers it? It calls to mind the saying, “don’t shoot the messenger!” Why is this? This is, because in human terms, the messenger is associated with the person delivering the message. Similarly, this is the case when it concerns the Word of God, and if we don’t like the message, we just silence the messenger. Jesus receives the same treatment. The vineyard owner said to Himself, “If I send my Son, they will respect Him.” But when the vineyard tenants saw the Son they said, “Come, let us kill [and silence] him and acquire his inheritance!” Mt 21:37-38 Is the story familiar? Of course it is.

If they don’t like the message, they just silence the messenger! Elijah figured it out. He takes refuge in the desert, but God calls him out to account for his whereabouts, “Why are you here, Elijah? Go back!” 1Kgs 19:13b,15 (You were sent to do my work, now go and do it.) It is not for the weak of heart to be a prophet of God. To be zealous for our God may very well cost us our life, but a life sacrificed for the Truth is worth living when it gives us everlasting joy in the Living God, Jesus Christ.

Let us take part in the Bread of Life Discourse in a way that others will follow suit, as the prophet Elisha does on Elijah’s example (2Kgs 2:9). Each generation must be more passionate than the last, wanting to be more zealous for their God, the life of the world.

Let us break completely with our sinful ways and remove all malice from our thoughts, words and actions says Saint Paul, and clothe ourselves in the Baptism of God’s righteous and holy truth. Listen to the message with a discerning heart of truth instead of dismissing the messenger on prejudice. It might just be the Word of God coming to us in our most fervent moments. Let His Spirit teach us to come to Him, and share in the Bread of Life.

**“I am the living bread that came down from Heaven, whoever eats this bread will live forever; and the bread that I give is my flesh for the life of the world.” Jn 6:51**


