

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

Our celebration of the Assumption of the Blessed Virgin Mary has roots in the ancient traditions of our faith. The official proclamation was made by Pius XII on November 1, 1950. Our belief in the Assumption of Mary gives us hope and a source of intercession for our resurrection.

We have a unique devotion to the Blessed Mother as Catholics. On Sundays, we proclaim her as the Virgin Mary in our profession of faith. We profess that she conceived by the power of the Holy Spirit and gave birth to Jesus, the only Son of God. We also believe that she was conceived in the womb of her mother, St. Ann, without original sin. That mystery of our faith prepared her to be the mother of Jesus.

Did you know we believe that death is the result of original sin? Mary then is unique and not made subject to the corruption of the grave. We celebrate that Mary did not have to wait till the end of time for the unity of her soul and body in heaven. She was assumed into heaven both soul and body.

Our Church teaches that immediately after death, our soul separates from our earthly body and we stand before God for judgement. We then enter heaven, Purgatory or hell. At the end of time, our Lord will come again to judge the living and the dead. All souls will be rejoined with their bodies, and those in Purgatory will be joined to the blessed in heaven.

Our celebration of the Assumption gives us great hope. We know how to live as believers in the Gospel. Today, we ask for intercession of Our Blessed Mother to help us on our pilgrimage to heaven and to be brought to the glory of the resurrection.

Nuestra celebración de la Asunción de la Santísima Virgen María tiene sus raíces en las antiguas tradiciones de nuestra fe. El anuncio oficial fue hecho por Pío XII el 1 de noviembre de 1950. Nuestra fe en la Asunción de María nos da esperanza y una fuente de intercesión por nuestra resurrección.

Tenemos una devoción única a la Santísima Virgen como católicos. Los domingos la proclamamos Virgen María en nuestra profesión de fe. Profesamos que ella concibió por el poder del Espíritu Santo y dio a luz a Jesús, el único Hijo de Dios. También creemos que fue concebida en el vientre de su madre, Santa Ana, sin pecado original. Ese misterio de nuestra fe la preparó para ser la madre de Jesús.

Todas las almas se reunirán con sus cuerpos, y los del Purgatorio se unirán a los bienaventurados en el cielo.

Nuestra celebración de la Asunción nos da una gran esperanza. Sabemos vivir como creyentes en el Evangelio. Hoy pedimos la intercesión de Nuestra Santísima Madre para que nos ayude en nuestra peregrinación al cielo y seamos llevados a la gloria de la resurrección.

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth
August 15, 2021*

“My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my savior.” Lk 1:46-47

The Canticle of Mary in Luke’s Gospel starts with these two lines; what a beautiful song of love for one’s God!

Do we exult and praise and sing to our Lord? Does our spirit have zeal for the Creator of all things that we sing a hymn of praise as we rise and go to our rest everyday? A child does.

A child would put into song their joys of wonder and amazement. A child would sing of exuberant happiness of heart. And a child would rejoice for the intimacy of the saving love of a loving God. A child of God would, as did the Blessed and Holy, ever-virgin Mother of God, Mary. We also should live, as children of God and of light, singing His praises, “for light produces every kind of goodness and righteousness and truth.” Eph 5:9

Saint Paul doesn’t hesitate to say how we should seek our Lord to gain His wisdom, through which flows the font of life. “Try to learn what is pleasing to the Lord. Awake, O who sleep, and arise from the death of darkness, and Christ will give you the light of understanding. Watch carefully then how you live, … making the most of the opportunities that arise, because the days of evil are at hand. Therefore, do not continue in ignorance, but try to understand what is the will of the Lord!” Eph 5:10,14b-17

The most revealing part of Saint Paul’s letter to the Ephesians is that of the urgency and immediacy of his words as he faces likely his final days imprisoned in Rome. His words convey a heightened sense of awareness as to the weight of those words, as they will be read not only by those in Ephesus, but also in all the new Christian communities around the world. In this state, Paul’s words transcend the role of any community per se, and become a doxology in truth and understanding through Jesus Christ.

So, why are we talking about a Pauline letter in describing Mary’s song of praise? Because Paul elucidates the reason for Mary’s praises. As we seek our God to love and serve Him, we find an understanding in Him through Christ that makes our souls sing for joy in praise of Him. The more urgent we seek this understanding, the more elated we are with the knowledge of the love He has for us. Awe struck with wonder and amazement, our hearts sing:

“My soul proclaims the greatness of the Lord; my spirit rejoices in God my savior.” Lk 1:46-47
