ONE SUNDAY FOR THE WHOLE WORLD EVERY YEAR, SOMETHING SPECIAL HAPPENS on the next-to-last Sunday of October. **WORLD MISSION SUNDAY** joins all Catholics of the world into one community of faith. At Mass that Sunday, we recommit ourselves to our common vocation, through Baptism to be missionaries, through prayer, participation in the Eucharist, and by giving generously to the collection for the Society for the Propagation of the Faith. Pope Francis' message for World Mission Sunday this year reflects on the theme: "We cannot but speak about what we have seen and heard" (Acts 4:20). He reminds us that, "as Christians, we cannot keep the Lord to ourselves," as we "recall with gratitude all those men and women who by their testimony of life help us to renew our baptismal commitment to be generous and joyful apostles of the Gospel." On World Mission Sunday, we join our Holy Father in supporting his missions. As we pray and respond here at home, we share in those celebrations taking place in every parish and school throughout the world. Together, through our prayers and financial support, we bring the Lord's mercy and concrete help to the most vulnerable communities in the Pope's missions. In a world where so much divides us, World Mission Sunday rejoices in our unity as missionaries by our Baptism, as it offers each one of us an opportunity to support the life-giving presence of the Church among the poor and marginalized in more than 1,111 mission dioceses.

*A Sunday Reflection

October 24, 2021*

During the Consecration in the Canon of the Mass, the priest recites the Eucharistic prayers that offer up the Victim in the Sacrifice of the Mass (Jesus Christ) in accordance with the words spoken at the Last Supper – presenting them to God, the Father and asking Him to accept this (perfect and unblemished) Sacrifice “as once He accepted the sacrifices of His servants Abel, Abraham (our father in faith), and that of His high priest, Melchizedek.”

So who is Melchizedek?

He was the king of Salem later Jeru-Salem of the land of Canaan. His name seems to mean ‘king of peace and reverence’ from the Hebrew word ‘shalom’. Yet, Melchizedek is the king and priest who blessed Abraham after his successful campaign against the five kings of southern Canaan (probably closer to the Dead Sea), and held a banquet in his honor blessing the bread and wine to be served. Abraham in return, gave Melchizedek a tenth of his spoils as tithe to the God, Most High (God of Melchizedek of Jerusalem and later God of Abraham and Isaac and Jacob (Israel)). Since the priest king Melchizedek’s lineage is not recounted, it follows that from a Christian perspective, God chose and chooses priests for Himself in the Old and New Covenant, who swear an oath to serve Him.

As an interesting note however, using the etymology of the Hungarian language we can deduce that Melchizedek is a descendant of Melchah (Melchah-ivadék). Nahor ('Nagy Úr' = high lord), Abraham's brother who married Milcah (of Melchah) bore him eight children and his concubine bore him four. From them descended 12 nations as with Jacob (Israel) who married Rebekah and Leah. Milcah bore Bethuel ('Betű-él' = living word) father of Rebekah ('Rebegé' = utterance). Abraham's name means 'my image.' The God Most High, God of the Hebrews is El Elyon ('El Eljen' or 'El Eljön' = God who lives and keeps living or who lives and will come again.)

Through the priestly oath comes the grace to approach the throne of God. Similarly, Christ Jesus who with no apparent blood line to the Levitical or Aaronic priestly families is high priest in the order of Melchizedek. Therefore, Jesus is able to save all who draw near Him, because they are drawn to the Father through Him. And this is the point, that an oath to God to serve Him has always been the example to follow. Although we know through divine revelation that Jesus is the Son of God, those of the Old Covenant such as Melchizedek and Elijah whose lineage were not recorded were also drawn to God by oaths they gave to serve Him.
