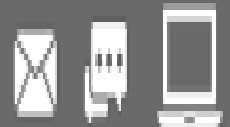

**Synod on Synodality**

**Journeying Together:** The entire Catholic Church is called to participate in the upcoming Synod of Bishops! The upcoming Synod is entitled: "For a Synodal Church: Communion, Participation, and Mission." Synod is a Greek word (synodos) meaning a meeting or assembly. The two Greek words that make up Synod are syn meaning together and hodos meaning way or journey. Pope Francis has called the entire People of God to journey together! This Synod is not just another meeting with oral presentations and written reports. This Synod is a process of journeying together. As the Church, we will listen to each other, dialogue with each other, pray together, discern together and make decisions together for the purpose of proclaiming the Gospel of Jesus Christ to the world!

Pope Francis is asking each local diocese to gather together- clergy, religious and laity- to first listen to each other's joys and hopes, and griefs and anxieties (c.f. Gaudium et Spes no. 1). After we listen to each other, we are called to dialogue together on ways we can accompany each other as we seek to grow in holiness. Listening and speaking within the Church always involves prayer. We are listening, dialoguing and praying together so that we can hear the voice of the Holy Spirit. The "goal" of this journeying together is not to create a new vision or pastoral plan with objectives. Rather, the goal of our journeying together is to be present with one another, to listen and learn with each other, and to grow closer to the Lord and His Church.

Eucharistic 40 Hours have been scheduled for each deanery of the Diocese of Metuchen. The 40 Hours will conclude with a listening session. The Eucharistic 40 Hours will take place on Sunday, January 23<sup>rd</sup> - Tuesday, January 25<sup>th</sup>. Our deanery has been scheduled to take place at Saint Bartholomew Church, East Brunswick. The Eucharistic 40 Hours will begin at 6:00 PM at St. Bartholomew Church on Sunday, January 23<sup>rd</sup>. **Caminando juntos:** ¡Toda la Iglesia Católica está llamada a participar en el próximo Sínodo de los Obispos! El próximo Sínodo se titula: "Por una Iglesia sinodal: Comunión, participación y misión". Sínodo es una palabra griega (synodos) que significa reunión o asamblea. Las dos palabras griegas que componen el Sínodo son syn, que significan juntas y hodos, que significan camino o viaje. ¡El Papa Francisco ha llamado a todo el Pueblo de Dios a caminar juntos! Este Sínodo no es un encuentro más con presentaciones orales e informes escritos. Este Sínodo es un proceso de caminar juntos. Como Iglesia, nos escucharemos unos a otros, dialogaremos, oraremos juntos, discerniremos juntos y tomaremos decisiones juntos con el propósito de proclamar el Evangelio de Jesucristo al mundo.

El Papa Francisco está pidiendo a cada diócesis local que se reúnan (clérigos, religiosos y laicos) para escuchar primero las alegrías y esperanzas de los demás, y los dolores y ansiedades (cf. Gaudium et Spes n. ° 1). Después de escucharnos unos a otros, somos llamados a dialogar juntos sobre las formas en que podemos acompañarnos mientras buscamos crecer en santidad. Escuchar y hablar en la Iglesia siempre implica oración. Estamos escuchando, dialogando y orando juntos para poder escuchar la voz del Espíritu Santo. *A Sunday Reflection  
by István Horváth  
January 16, 2022*

"Again Jesus said [to his disciples], 'Peace be with you! As the Father has sent me, I am sending you.' And with that He breathed on them and said, 'Receive the Holy Spirit.'" Jn 20:21-22 "No one can say, 'Jesus is Lord', except in [receipt of] the Holy Spirit. 1Cor 12:3 There are different kinds of gifts [of the Spirit], but the same Spirit distributes them. There are different kinds of service [to our Lord], but only one Lord. There are many different forms of good works, but it is the same one God in each of us that works the good. The manifestation of the Spirit to each of us is different so that a common good can be done." 1Cor 12:3b-7 (partially paraphrased)

And so, when the mother of Our Lord at the Wedding at Cana, turns to Jesus and says to Him, "They have no wine!" Jn 2:3, we see that the Spirit intervenes for the common good and manifests itself in Jesus even though He questions whether His hour has come. Jn 2:4

When we receive the gifts and graces of the Holy Spirit, Jesus tells us that we are to do so for the common good. The gifts include our talents with which our person is born, and also those that we acquire through knowledge, fortitude, understanding and wisdom. The remaining three (counsel, piety and fear of the Lord) are those gifts that we can act through and utilize to do good for others.

The point is that our gifts and talents are not there to stow away and hide or to profit from selfishly. They are given to us for the purpose of sharing them with each other and not for the purpose of controlling, belittling or exploiting others with them for our benefit. And they are certainly not for acquiring great wealth at others' expense. Our talents and gifts that we receive are the means by which we communicate God's image within us to everyone else around us. Their rewards and benefits will be reflected in those that we meet, in the same measure of respect we have for their person and salvation. Yes, that is correct, we are responsible for others' salvation not only our own. This is how good conquers evil. That is the Pentecost Jesus is waiting to return to that fulfills His mission through us and our mission towards all of God's creation.

**God is faithful; by Him you were called into the fellowship of His Son, Jesus Christ our Lord. 1Cor 1:9 The Lord, who is faithful has chosen you. Is 49:7b**

Saint Paul reminds the Corinthians that staying faithful to the Spirit is part of our responsibility in doing God's will. This in the very least is obeying His commandments, but as Isaiah points out everything that we do that isn't His will leads to nothingness and vanity. Is 49:4 And the reason we should be doing His will is because God has remained faithful to us despite the fact that we have not been faithful to Him.

But if we look at this from a different point of view, the fact that God, the Father knows us personally (Is 49:1b, 5a) and created us for the purpose of being happy with him, then it carries even more weight that we be obedient to Him and sanctify His creations by forming them to His will.

How do we sanctify God's creations? We can't even do anything of use or importance without His help. Well, that's exactly the point! If we understand that we are nothing and useless without God, then we rely on Him completely and trust Him without conditions; this is true faith. By having true faith in God, we have true inheritance in Jesus Christ His Son and are able to sanctify the created world by the power of His will. We become creators of good and goodness through the sanctity of Jesus, our Lord. Our actions will bear fruit many times the effort we invest and our happiness will start to grow through the joy we bring to others. The take-home message is: God has a plan for us as long as we have faith in Him.
