A Sunday Reflection

February 6, 2022

**“Holy, holy, holy is the Lord of Hosts!
All the earth is filled with His glory!” Is 6:3**

The seraphim flew over to Isaiah and touched his mouth with the burning ember from the altar of God and said, “See, now that this has touched your lips, your wickedness is removed, your sin forgiven.” Is 6:6-7

Jesus, knowing that His hour had come to pass from this world to go to the Father, and removing His outer garments and tying a towel about His waist, then pouring water into a basin washed His Disciples feet saying, “Do you realize what I have done for you? As I have done for you, you should also do [with each other]. Amen, amen, I say to you, no slave is greater than his master nor any messenger greater than the one who sent him. I say to you, whoever receives *the one* I send receives *me*, and whoever receives *me* receives *the one* who sent *me*” Jn 13:1-20

Truly, God gives signs to his followers that: baptism washes away Original Sin, the sin of Adam and Eve, and reveals to us the Spirit of God. But even more revealing is the fact that Isaiah, the great prophet of the Old Testament had first to be cleansed of wickedness and not just sin of his words. If that is true, then it reveals to us, we too can all be saints and prophets, if we want to be. Yes, if we want to be. We have to want it. That is how free will works. We have to want to be in Jesus and with the Father. This is the meaning of Jesus washing the Disciples feet: if you humble yourself to the Son, you will receive the inheritance of the Father through the Son’s blood sacrifice on the cross. By subjugating your will to the will of the Son and thereby the Father, you will become holy and your words prophetic and your actions saintly: a Gospel of true love from the Father of all creation, Jesus Christ.
