

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,
The words of Jesus in today's gospel are words of encouragement. The life of a follower of Jesus is not always easy. Today's gospel gives us consolation and hope.

Our gospel reading begins with Jesus approaching a level area of ground. He had just returned from a night of prayer in a mountain region. Early in the morning he chose 12 people who would be called the 12 apostles from the disciples that were with him. The 12 apostles were with Jesus as he entered the level area.

The instruction that Jesus presented is referred to as "The Sermon on the Plain." This instruction reminds of our dependence on God. Jesus states very directly that He is the source of salvation and true happiness. Jesus warns us that if we look to this world to provide happiness, riches, and praise, then our satisfaction will one day end. We are invited to work for the happiness, riches and praise that will last in eternal life. We know that this will mean sacrifice and criticism at times. However, Jesus assures us that our reward will be great in heaven.

Let us pray for the patience and support for one another on our pilgrimage to heaven.

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth*
February 13, 2022

“Blessed are you when people hate you, ... exclude and insult you, and denounce your name as evil on account of the Son of Man.” Lk 6:22

“But woe to you ... who have received your consolation. ... who laugh now, ... [of whom] all speak well of ...” Lk 6:24-26

So what is Jesus saying to us? We can't have fun? No one should speak well of us or our deeds?

Not at all! Rather, Jesus is referring to what we should aspire is not what others say or think of us, but rather what God thinks of us and our deeds.

We should remain humble at all cost; it should discomfort us, if we are praised without God himself being praised in the process, as the means to our success.

It is not that we should not make a living to support our families and those that depend on us, but rather the aspiration for unnecessary riches of which Jesus speaks.

It is not that we should not laugh and have fun certainly for the sake of our friends, family and children, but rather that we share that laughter with others so that it is not just self-serving.

God wants us to be happy in this life as well, even if we must suffer to love and serve Him. However, loving this life and its pleasures, no matter how small they may seem is not what He wants for or from us. This is, because loving any part of the physical world is a temporal act and will fade and cease to be. He wants us to have lasting joy with Him in heaven. This can only be achieved if we free ourselves of things and share in the joy of making others happy through self-sacrifices. By sharing in others' suffering and consoling them, helping them laugh at our expense, caring for their needs and accepting their burdens as ours, do we truly experience happiness and joy in the spiritual sense. It is with this spirit of giving and charity that God wishes to make us happy on earth, all the while interacting with His creation with the love Christ showed us to become similar to Him or Christ-like.

The Beatitudes are blessings we receive towards a way of life that if followed, lead to holiness. Faith in our God to come to our aid, hope in our one Living God to bring justice to our plight, and in service to our God through charity towards our brethren is living and loving as a Christian. 1Cor 13:13 Sharing the gift of God's love in us with others transforms suffering and sacrifice into overwhelming happiness and joy in our lives.
