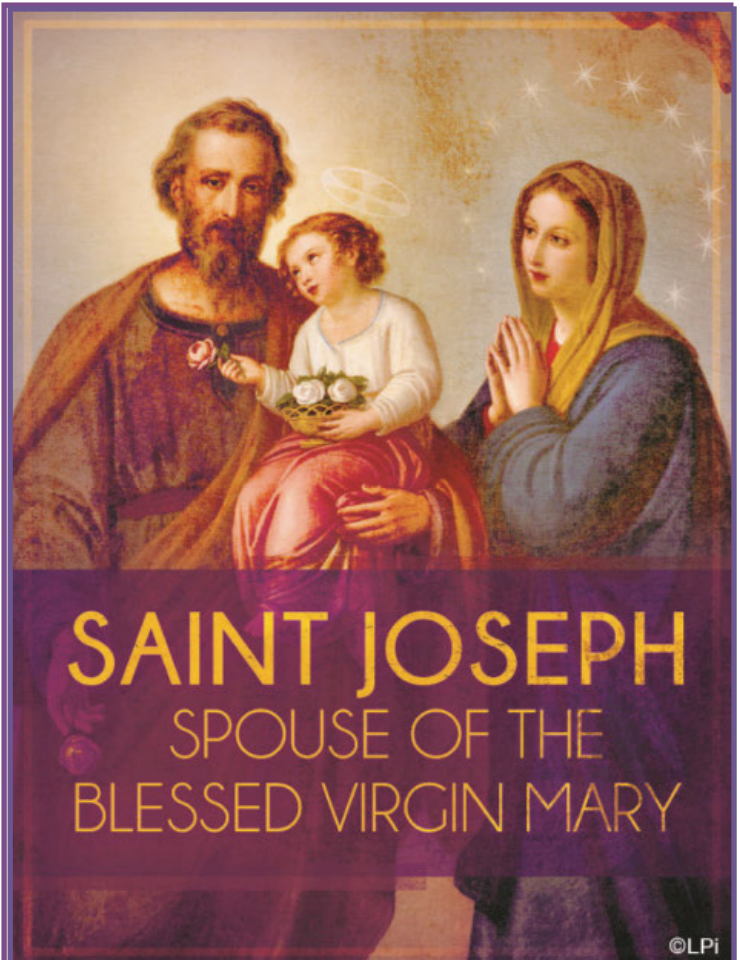

PASTOR'S MESSAGE

Dear Parishioners and Friends of Holy Family Parish,

At times, Jesus gives profound insight to his identity to his disciples. The selection of our gospel reading is the account of the transfiguration of our Lord. This event indicated the identity of Jesus and gave strength to his apostles. This strength is extended to us on our Lenten Journey and lifelong pilgrimage to heaven.

The transfiguration of Jesus was a profound event in the scriptures. The appearance of Moses and Elijah represented the Law and the Prophets. It is by living of the Law and the direction of the prophets that God's chosen people direct their lives. It is also the living of their relationship with God. To have both Moses and Elijah is to demonstrate a new relationship being established. It was said that they would appear at the time of the arrival of the savior. No longer is the relationship bound by the strict observance of the Law and the prophets. Jesus invites all to a new relationship with him. A relationship that is the fulfillment of the words of the prophets and the Law.

The event of the transfiguration reveals the humanity and divinity of Jesus. This revelation is a source of strength for the apostles. The challenges that they experienced did not hamper their ministry. They knew that Jesus can offer something more magnificent than this world can give.

How often we begin the Lenten season with the intention to use this time to strengthen our relationship with Jesus. However, the challenges of our daily lives interfere with this intention. Today, Jesus reveals his love for us and invites us to strengthen our love for him. Let us pray that we recognize the support that Jesus gives to us today. Support that encourages us on this Lenten journey and the lifelong pilgrimage of our lives.

*A Sunday Reflection
by István Horváth
March 13, 2022*

“That we may be made worthy of the promises of Christ.”
We pray in the Angelus, Salve Regina, and the Litany of the Blessed Virgin Mary.

What are the promises of Christ you might ask?

We heard it four weeks ago. “Blessed are those that are poor, for the kingdom of God is yours. Blessed are you who are now hungry, ...” Lk 6:20-23, Mt 5:2-12 and so on. And

“In my Father’s house there is much room. ... I have told you that I am going to prepare a place for you ... so that where I am you also may be.” Jn 14:2-3, 12:26, 17:24

God, through Jesus Christ fulfills His promise to mankind (Gn 15,17,18) and delivers His son, the Savior of the world. Jesus in turn spells this out for us in the Beatitudes. He also sheds light on what we might expect in Heaven, if we are faithful to his teachings and remain his disciples. And how do we respond?

I’ll have to get back to you, God; I’m busy with life just now. (Read Eccl 2-4)

How can we be too busy with life, if Life itself is Jesus Christ, Lord and God?! This life and the afterlife are living in Jesus Christ! But why would you wait to dress your wounds and heal your sicknesses, when the only chance you will have to do it is in this life? The afterlife is a fixed state alterable only by prayer from this life. I wouldn’t want to take that chance would you?

So you ask, “Why can’t others see that I’m Catholic?” Maybe because we aren’t living as Jesus Christ taught us. Just maybe we are too busy living for this world, rather than living for His world. And maybe, His promises aren’t what we seek anymore. Well then, guess what, you’re not Catholic, you’re not even Christian, you’re like those lost to the world that will pass and become nothing: vanity of vanities. Because “for you are dust and to dust you shall return.” Gn 3:19

Do we wish to remain in the world Before Christ, or are we ready to change our lives, die with Him to the world on the cross, and rise with Him to a new life, in the era of The Resurrection? This is Christ transfigured in us. This is to be confirmed in Christ. This is what Christ showed his trusted disciples on Mount Tabor. Lk 9:28-36 This is Christ’s promise to us. If we keep His Commandments and stay faithful to Him, we will have eternal life in Him.

So we should ask often: does the world see us as followers of Christ, as His disciples, as Catholics? Or do they insist, “You’re not Catholic ... you’re like us!” Or if found out, we respond as Peter did, “I do not know the man!” Mt 26:74

Everyday that you wakeup you have the opportunity to die to your selfish wants and a life of vanity that leads to eternal death and nothingness, or respond to God’s eternal love, live in the Resurrected Christ and in the Trinity of the Holy Spirit and exercise your will to uphold His Laws. Everyday you have the choice to choose life with Christ that leads to eternal life. Free will: your choice.
