



Dear Families and Friends of Holy Family Parish,


The journey of the three wise men to the city of Bethlehem was a journey of faith. A journey that included a purpose, a direction and a change. Our pilgrimage of faith, like the journey of the wise men likewise include a purpose, a direction and often moments of growth. The three wise men set out to find the new born king of the Jews. They left the safety of their homelands and ventured into the unfamiliar. They were guided by a bright star in the sky. The star rested over the location of Jesus together with Mary and Joseph.

Their journey to find the new born king was over when they presented their gifts to Jesus and paid him homage. They even demonstrated the ultimate posture of respect, to prostrate themselves. Nuestra peregrinación de fe, como el viaje de los reyes magos, también incluye un propósito, una dirección y, a menudo, momentos de crecimiento. Los tres reyes magos partieron en busca del recién nacido rey de los judíos. Abandonaron la seguridad de sus países de origen y se aventuraron en lo desconocido. A Sunday Reflection

Epiphany: A revelation of God through extra-ordinary, divine or supernatural means for the benefit of man as represented by the Magi of the East, manifested in the divine being of Christ.

Jesus' birth in the person of God the Son, the Messiah, King of the Jews is also revealed to "wise men", the Magi of the world, not of the Jews. It is a clear indication that God is addressing all of His creation in man not just his chosen people of old to whom He keeps His promise to bring the Savior into the world through their genealogy.

Saint Paul clarifies this truth in Ephesians regarding his revelation or epiphany that was made known to him for our benefit. "That the Gentiles are coheirs, members of the same body, and copartners in the promise in Christ Jesus through the Gospel." **Eph 3:6** And "to me [Paul], the very least of all the holy ones, this grace was given, to preach to the Gentiles the inscrutable riches of Christ." **Eph 3:8**

Hence, the Epiphany of Jesus Christ is to all of human kind, not just God's long chosen people [Israel] **Gn 35:10**. But through them and "to his holy ones [by the Spirit], to whom God chose to make known the riches of the glory of this mystery among the Gentiles; it is Christ in you." **Col 1:27** Therefore, "Christ in you" is how God reveals His most intimate mysteries to man. We learn the mysteries of God by love for one another!

What an epiphany that is: **Christ in me** reveals to others God's love for mankind.

The Baptism of Our Lord Jesus Christ:

Through the action of baptism God gives signs to his followers that: baptism in water cleanses or washes away Original Sin, the sin of Adam and Eve; this is sin in the Old Covenant before a knowledge of God the Son is revealed to world. The water of baptism gives us new life in God, and brings forth new life as in the natural world. **Is 55:11** This new life is the new understanding of who God is and His relationship to man in the natural world.

The action of Jesus' baptism is both a sign and an epiphany as was his birth. And again "the heavens were opened [for him], and he saw the Spirit of God descending like a dove [and] coming upon him. And a voice ... saying, 'This is my beloved Son, with whom **I am** well pleased.'" **Mt 3:16-17**
