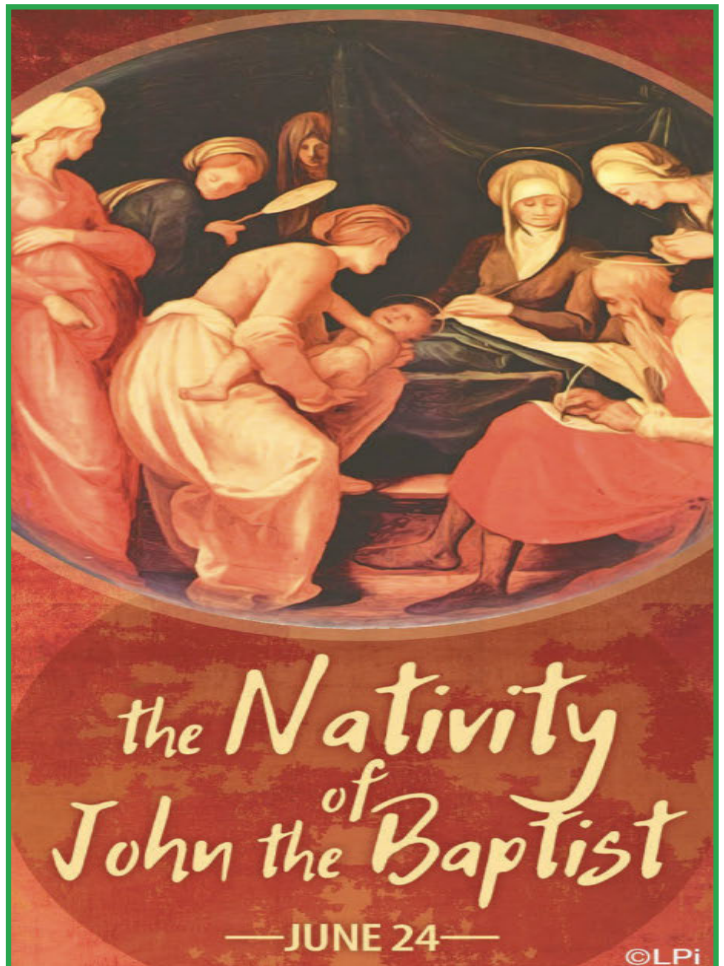

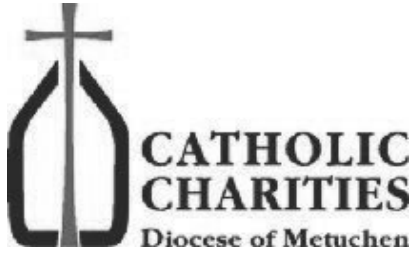

Twelfth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“God did not make death, nor does He rejoice in the destruction of the living. For He fashioned all things that they might have being, and the creatures of the world are wholesome.” “For God formed us to be imperishable; the image of his own nature He made us.” **Wis 1:13-14b, 2:23**

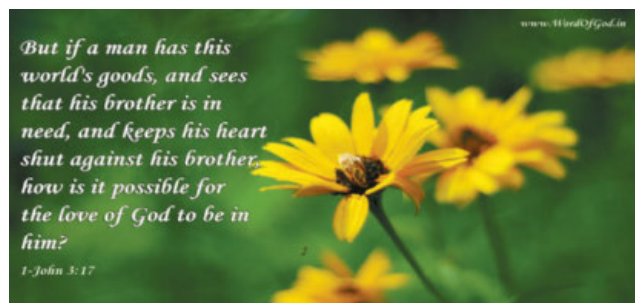
Why are these words above paired with the raising of Jairus’ daughter and the healing of the hemorrhaging woman in **Mark 5:21-42**? Could it be that our faith in the Living God has healing power and transcends death and we are just unaware of this fact? Jesus points out to the crowd, “The child is not dead but asleep.”

Yes. It is exactly that obvious, yet few accept it and even fewer believe it to be true. How many times have you heard from Jesus, the Son of the Living God, “your faith has saved you or cured you.” **Mk 5:34** “Everything is possible to one who has faith.” **Mk 9:23** Then as now, Jesus shows us the way to everlasting life and we just laugh it off like the wailing crowd around the death of Jairus’ daughter who were told that she is asleep.

It is rather obvious then that we don’t understand Jesus’ words when He says to Martha and His disciples, “***I am the resurrection and the life, whoever believes in me, even if he dies, will live, and everyone who lives and believes in me will never die!***” **Jn 11:25-26** What is it to die and yet live, and to live and never die?

If we believe in Him and the One who sent Him, we will die to our sins by His sacrifice on the cross, and pass from the death of our sinful state to a new life of grace in His resurrection. And by the Baptism of water and Spirit a new life is conferred upon us in Confirmation so that we may have power to grow in the life of grace and courage to profess our faith, do good deeds and keep His Commandments. With these marks of faith and with His body and blood to nourish our souls while we are here, we (our souls) will never die. Our bodies may fall asleep at the end of our natural life, but we awaken by His command to everlasting life in Him.

Let us share our gifts of faith in Him by the “laying on of hands” so that others may be healed by the charity we show in our thoughts, in our words and in our deeds! Let us say to the Lord, I love you, and I trust in you completely. I will do everything you say defying my understanding, because I know you love me and have my best interest in mind. I want to be your child always.
