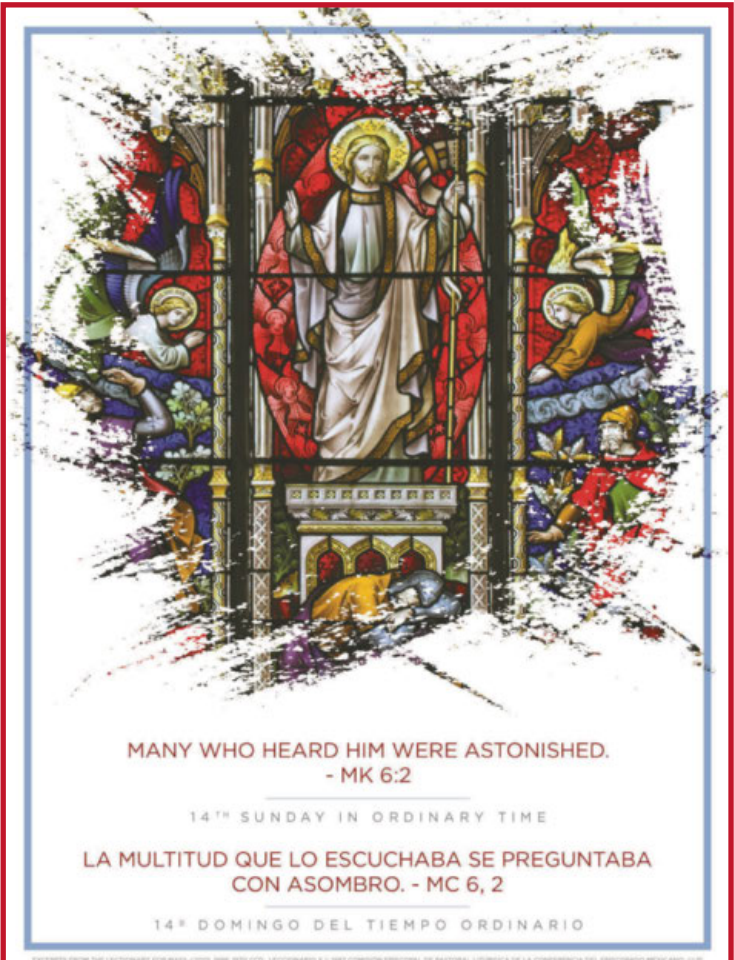

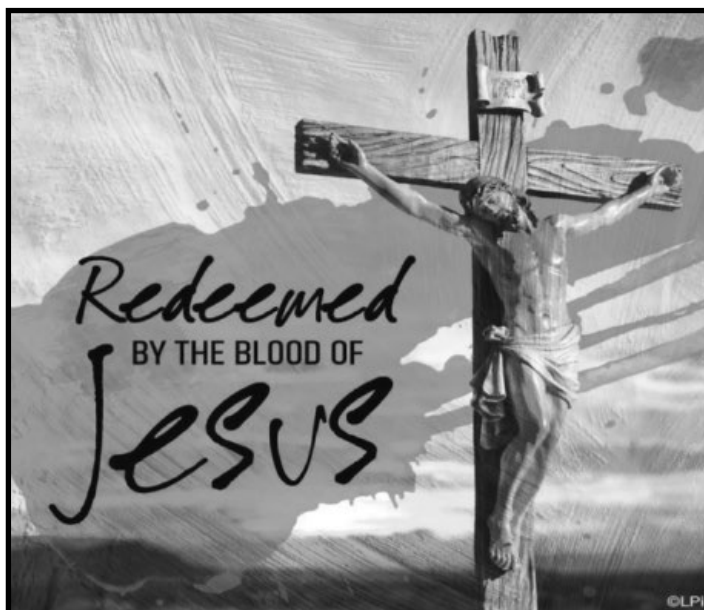

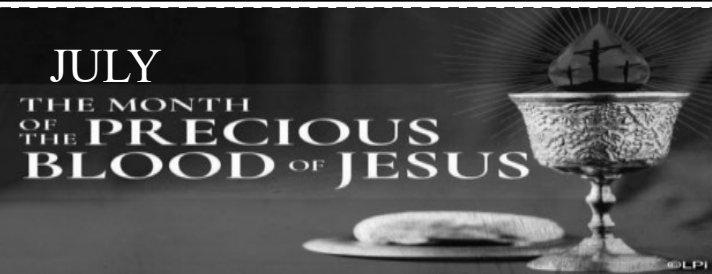

GOSPEL MEDITATION - ENCOURAGE DEEPER UNDERSTANDING OF SCRIPTURE

July 7, 2024

What does God want us to do with our weaknesses, if crushing them with willpower won't work? For example, what should I do with my tendency to arrogance and self-isolation? Or my procrastination? Or my intellectual and physical limitations? Or my selfishness?

The counter-intuitive answer is clear in this week's words from St Paul, "I will rather boast most gladly of my weaknesses in order that the power of Christ may dwell in me (2 Cor. 12:9)." Boast of our weaknesses? Paul isn't promoting weak-mindedness or laziness. Rather, he perceives that Jesus loves us not despite our weaknesses but because of them. Boasting of our weakness means claiming human will is not all we have. It means turning to God whenever we feel weak, which—let's face it—is almost all the time. When we do, we learn to love our weaknesses, because it's there that we meet the strength of Christ. .

STEWARDSHIP SCRIPTURE REFLECTION

July 7, 2024 - 14th Sunday in Ordinary Time

"As the Lord spoke to me, the spirit entered me and set me on my feet, and I heard the one who was speaking say to me, 'Son of man, I am sending you...'"
Ezekiel 2:2-3

God has a plan for each of us. He calls us to do something for Him. But, He doesn't leave us on our own to figure it out. He gives us the resources we need to do His work. Are you listening for God's call? When you hear it, do you get on your feet and do the work He asks of you? Do not be afraid. God doesn't call the equipped, he equips the called. Answer His call.

MEDITACIÓN DEL EVANGELIO – ALENTAR UN ENTENDIMIENTO MÁS PROFUNDO DE LA ESCRITURA

¿Qué quiere Dios que hagamos con nuestras debilidades, si aplastarlas con fuerza de voluntad no funciona? Por ejemplo, ¿qué debo hacer con mi tendencia a la arrogancia y al autoaislamiento? ¿O mi procrastinación? ¿O mis limitaciones intelectuales y físicas? ¿O mi egoísmo? La respuesta contraria a la intuición es clara en las palabras de San Pablo de esta semana: "Más bien, de buena gana me gloriaré en mis debilidades, para que el poder de Cristo more en mí (2 Cor. 12:9)". ¿Alardear de nuestras debilidades? Pablo no está promoviendo la debilidad mental o la pereza. Más bien, percibe que Jesús nos ama no a pesar de nuestras debilidades sino a causa de ellas. Alardear de nuestra debilidad significa afirmar que la voluntad humana no es todo lo que tenemos. Significa acudir a Dios cada vez que nos sentimos débiles, lo cual, seamos realistas, ocurre casi todo el tiempo. Cuando lo hacemos, aprendemos a amar nuestras debilidades, porque es allí donde encontramos la fuerza de Cristo.

A Sunday Reflection by István Horváth

Fourteenth Sunday in Ordinary Time

“... sending them out two by two... He instructed them to take nothing for the journey, but a walking stick – no food, no sack (of clothes), no money in their belts.” Mk 6:7-9

If we remember as a child, how we would go out into the meadows, the fields, the forests and down winding paths, and spend a half of a day, maybe more exploring nature, carefree and content to find nothing and still come home having found the world. Then that is how Jesus wants us to discover God by helping others, with that sort of faith in not knowing what we will find, but trusting all the while in His providence. **Mt 6:31-32a**

In our pursuit, we would forget whether we ate, or what time it was, whether we had any chores or responsibilities, and even whether we had siblings or parents, all that mattered was that we were discovering the mysteries of life around us. That life is God. His Spirit drove us out into the wilderness (**Mk 1:12, Lk 4:1**) to be fascinated, mesmerized, elated at the thought of finding Him in all what makes the world work, but also to remain faithful to Him.

Imagine doing that now! “Why that’s for kids not for adults,” we’d say. Indeed, that is for children, children of God. We forget that this is our life’s goal, to be children of God. Because to worry about “stuff” is for those who don’t believe in the Living God, they are the pagans who make and build everything around them to be idols of worship. They worry about their houses, cars, money, influence, family pride, the clothes they wear, which people they talk to, what they eat and what sort of viruses lurk behind surgical masks. Pathetic pathological lunacy may come to mind, but we should point the finger at ourselves first, because we tend to be our own worst enemy.

God wants us to be happy in the natural world. He wants us to get all the “worms” out of our system, the bodies He gave us, before we go and live with Him permanently. He doesn’t want us to yearn after the natural world, because that leads to death and destruction. This world is our exile before our promise, so that we can prove ourselves to be worthy of greater treasures, those of the soul.

“Therefore, I tell you, do not worry about your [bodily] life...Is not life more than food or clothing? Let tomorrow take care of itself. It is enough to deal with today’s evil.” **Mt 6:25-34**

Take faith in the Living God, from whom all good things come.
