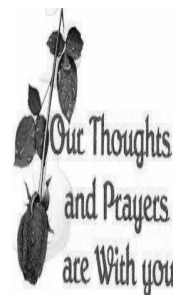

*A Sunday Reflection

Thirtieth Sunday in Ordinary Time

During the Consecration in the Canon of the Mass, the priest recites the Eucharistic prayers that offer up the Victim in the Sacrifice of the Mass (Jesus Christ) in accordance with the words spoken at the Last Supper – presenting them to God, the Father and asking Him to accept this (perfect and unblemished) Sacrifice “as once He accepted the sacrifices of His servants Abel, Abraham (our father in faith), and that of His high priest, Melchizedek.”

So who is Melchizedek?

He was the king of Salem later Jeru-Salem of the land of Canaan. His title seems to mean ‘king of peace and reverence’ from the Hebrew word ‘shalom’. And it was Melchizedek, king and priest of Salem who blessed Abraham after his successful campaign against the five kings of southern Canaan (probably closer to the Dead Sea). He held a banquet in his honor blessing the bread and wine to be served. Abraham in return, gave Melchizedek a tenth of his spoils as tithe to the God, Most High (God of Melchizedek of (Jeru)Salem and later God of Abraham and Isaac and Jacob (Israel)). Since the priest king Melchizedek’s lineage is not recounted, it follows that from a Christian perspective, God chose and chooses priests for Himself in the Old and New Covenant, who swear an oath to serve Him.

Through the priestly oath comes the grace to approach the throne of God. However, Christ Jesus who with no apparent blood line to the Levitical or Aaronic priestly families is high priest in the order of Melchizedek. **Ps 110:4 Heb Ch’s 5,7** And although, there was an effort by the Hebrew Christians to show a blood lineage for Jesus, from that of king David (**Mt 1:1-17**), this could not have been the case given the Virgin Birth of Jesus, Son of God. It seems more likely that God had to go back to an example prior to the Mosaic priestly orders to make His point of who and how He wants His servants to behave. Because in the Old Covenant servants of God, Most High such as Melchizedek and Elijah who were not Hebrews and whose lineage were not recorded were also drawn to God by oaths they gave to serve Him.

Jesus is able to save all who draw near Him, because they are drawn to the Father through Him. And this is the point, that an oath to God to serve Him has always been the example to follow to draw others to the service of God. Although we know through divine revelation that Jesus is the Son of God, those who are not related to Him by blood can swear an oath to God to serve Him. This oath then is the example of Abel, Melchizedek, Abraham, Elijah and finally and firstly Jesus Christ. By their example then do the priests of God present their sacrifice at the Altar of God, and it is God Himself, Who becomes our sacrificial lamb and Victim at the same time as He is High Priest forever in each and every Mass. **Heb 5:10**
