A Sunday Reflection

Fifth Sunday in Lent

“Thus says the Lord, [your God,] your redeemer, ‘Behold: I [bring to pass and] accomplish something new... for ... the people whom I formed for myself, that they might recount my praises.’” Is 43:14-21

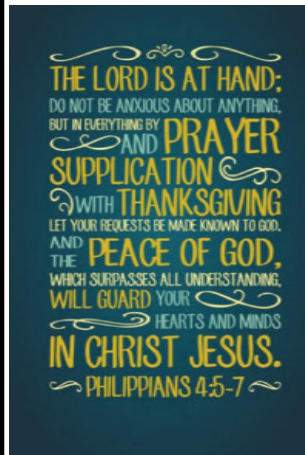
Who are those people that Isaiah’s God is talking about and what is the something new?

Well, literally it is Israel, Jacob’s descendents of whom God speaks, however we find that in an earlier passage **Is 43:7** this is not all God’s people, but rather “All who are called by my name I created for my glory; I formed them, [and] made them.” So, it does include all who hear Jesus’ calling and follow His word.

And then, what is this new something of which God speaks of?

New to Isaiah, but by Jesus’ time not new to the Pharisees, Sadducees or Essenes. What is new is the coming of the Redeemer, the Savior of the world (**Ps 78:35, Is 41:14b, 47:4, 48:17, 54:5**), whose ransom God is providing by the deliverance of His son, the Son of Man, Son of the living God. Yet, whom many still did not recognize nor accept in the person of Jesus Christ.

So, besides being new, how is Jesus different from the Old Testament prophets including John the Baptist? For one thing, Jesus is the Son of the God of Israel, Who is God the Father, God Most High. He states unequivocally and on several occasions **Is 42:1, 43:10**, and the Spirit confirms his words. **Ps 2:7, Mt 3:17, 17:5, Mk 1:11, 9:7, 14:61-62, Lk 3:22, 9:35, Jn 16:28**



And this is new, because of how God perceives man’s sin in the world, rather than sin itself. God feels man requires a permanent and direct image of himself to emulate in Mary and in Jesus to undergo the transformation from the Old Covenant to the New. This transformation requires leaving behind everything that belongs to the physical world as Paul describes to the Philippians **Phil 3:8-14** and becoming Christ-like. It includes forgiving those that

hurt you, scorn you and hate you. It includes loving and sacrificing for your neighbor rather than yourself. And it includes letting go of all things that are not pleasing to Him in our thoughts, words and actions, and in our behavior, habits and weaknesses.

The NEW something that God, Jesus and His disciples refer to is the ‘person within’ who needs to be re-born in Christ’s love for our fellow man. So, the redeeming power of Christ is for all who hear his call to be re-born in the Spirit of the Trinitarian God through true repentance and sacrifice towards their fellow man, that they may share in His promise and glory of the Resurrection.
