



*A Sunday Reflection*

As we listen to the accounts of the Disciples with the Risen Christ from early dawn on Easter Sunday morning to Pentecost Sunday, it is the words of the New Testament that we hear.

This is for a reason. In the Old Testament, God sent prophets and great seers to warn and guide His people, Israel, but all along, God's plan was for all His creation to share in His Glory. So, He called Abraham out of Úr to be His people's father in faith and all those who believe in Him. Now, when His chosen people wouldn't listen, He made yet other attempts to bring them to salvation as The Parable of the Tenants relates to us God's account of their behavior. "Finally, he sent his son to them, thinking, 'They will respect my son [, surely (he represents me)].' But when the tenants saw the son, they said to one another, 'This is the heir. Come let us kill him and acquire his inheritance.' ... "What will the owner of the vineyard do...?" Jesus asks. "They answered him, 'He will put those wretched men to a wretched death and lease his vineyard to other tenants who will give him the produce at the proper times.' Jesus said to them, ... **Therefore, I say to you, the kingdom of God will be taken away from you and given to a people that will produce its fruit."** Mt 21:33-43

So, with Jesus' resurrection and ascension into Heaven we are now heirs to the fullness of God's plan for mankind, we too have the tools to leave behind and transcend the natural world and obtain the gift of eternal life. We can be born into the natural world and Baptized and Confirmed in the Trinitarian God and be re-born in Jesus Christ without knowing all the Laws and Traditions that went into bringing about our Salvation. However, we must have faith strong enough to endure all adversity and suffering that the natural world imposes upon us and still believe the one God of Life will deliver us from our torment and our sins (read the story of Job). This is made possible by our hope in eternal life through Him and our sacrificial love of charity for our brethren in Christ. **1Cor13:13**

Our sins have been nailed to the cross in the person of Christ our Redeemer, and we are no longer slaves to the natural world. We can be re-born in Christ allowing us to transcend the natural world of death to the supernatural world of eternal life in Him. This communion with Christ is what John's Gospel, Luke's Acts of the Apostles, and Paul's Letters are all about. If we listen closely, we will find that in each encounter with the Risen Christ the Disciples are trying to describe in natural terms things that occur around them that are supernatural. They are frightened, but at the same time rejoice to see their Teacher and Lord still with them and teaching them about a life in the Living God.

And once the Disciples receive the gifts of the Holy Spirit, they are without fear or anxiety, and are emboldened by a new resolve to proclaim their joy to the world that includes peoples of all nations. Because we know Jesus Christ, and therefore we know God the Father, through which all things were made for our salvation and that of the whole world. **For the sake of His sorrowful Passion, have mercy on us and on the whole world.**
