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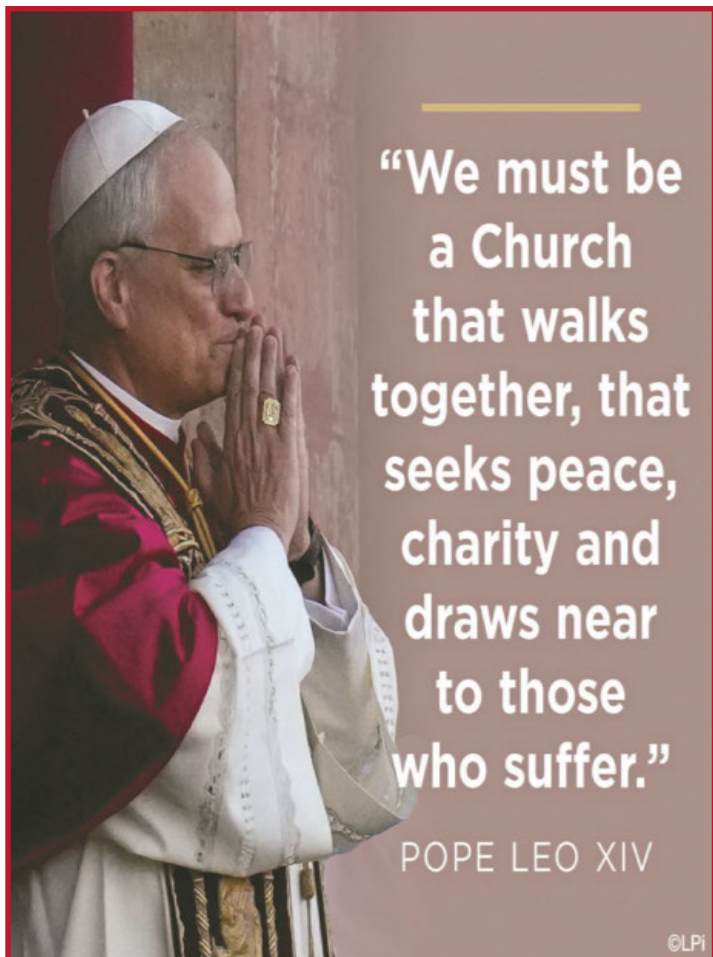

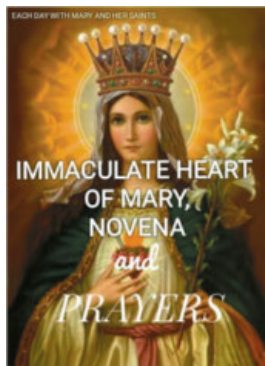

A Sunday Reflection

Building God's Kingdom on earth. What does this mean to us individually and as a community in Jesus Christ?
Acts 1:3

We read in Revelation 21 that the Risen Christ has assumed his place in Heaven to the right of God's throne as the rightful heir of Heaven and Earth. The New Jerusalem in Heaven is the Temple of Jesus Christ, the Lamb of God where a perfect Communion with the one Ever-Living God exists without the sacrifice of the Mass anymore. This Community still has walls, but these are more like boundaries of pure versus impure. Similar physically, to noble metals when they are purified in a crucible to remove impurities. This Heaven will come down to Earth when the new Earth is created for mankind. It will be man's new Eden, and God will dwell alongside man as Father and Son.

Will man be created once again? What will happen to those that are already here? Don't worry it's happened already! The new man has been created in Jesus Christ, and we are spiritual heirs to Him if we learn His teachings and keep His Commandment. **Jn 4:23; Jl 2:13; Ez 36:26**

Fortunately for us, we are not in the dark anymore like those of the Old Testament who lived before Christ Jesus was born into the world. Unfortunately for us, we forget that this is the fact time and time again, and we sin against His Holy Name and His Holy Presence. This happens when we don't act appropriately and don't revere the presence of the Blessed Sacrament and when we take Holy Communion disposed to mortal sin or with disregard to the true presence of the Body and Blood of Jesus Christ.

We may think we are getting away with it, because no one knows our sins, but we are deceiving ourselves and forfeiting our opportunity for salvation. We can only form and change our supernatural existence in the natural world, this is how God created it. After that, we must rely on the prayers of the faithful to get us to Heaven. Why take that chance? God created the natural world for us to achieve this and to help us to the state of sanctifying grace. **Gn 1:28a; Ps 8:7** However, the Evil One also has power over the physical world. **Jn 12:31; Jn 14:30** And so at the appropriate time, God sent His only son, Our Lord Jesus Christ to show us The Way, helping us along to achieve our goal. **Jn 14:6; Acts 9:2**



The supernatural state of existence can only be altered in the natural world; hence, God's creation of the world. He wanted His creation to dwell with Him in eternity, but by its own free will. If by free will we can lose paradise, then by this same free will we ought to be able to re-gain paradise as well. Therefore it follows that, building God's Kingdom on earth is an active state of existence, that we must constantly mold and form with the sacrifices we make for others through "faith, hope and love... but the greatest of these is love."
