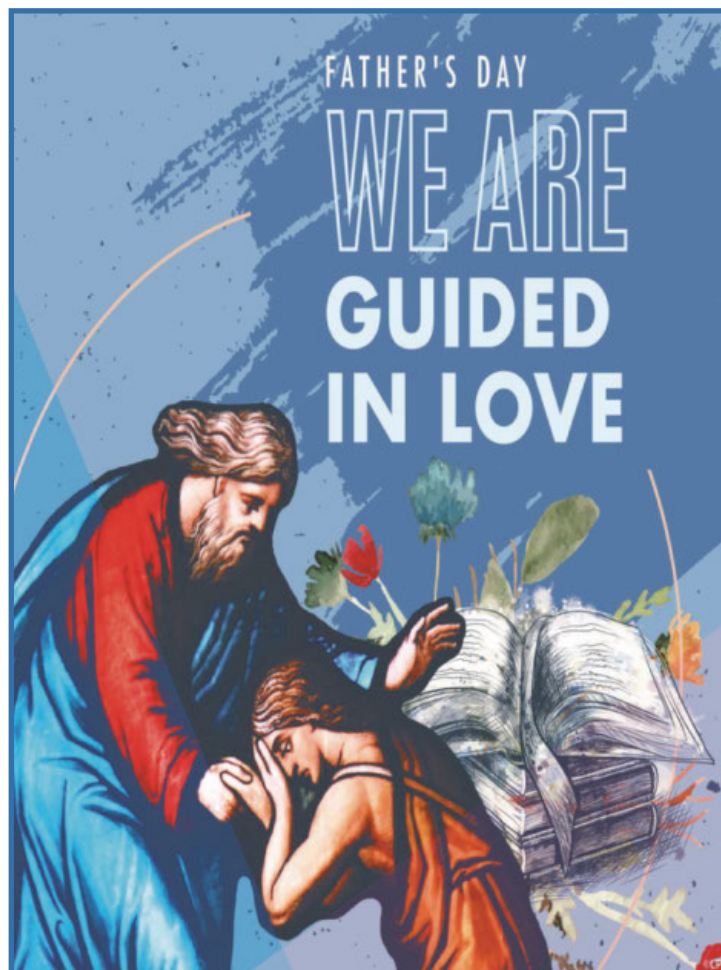

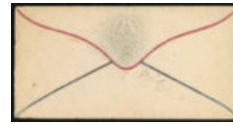

**2025 MISSION APPEAL
FOR AGULERI DIOCESE, NIGERIA**

Rev. Fred Ndimaeme of the Catholic
Diocese of Aguleri located in southeast-
ern Nigeria is coming to our parish on
June 21 - 22, 2025 to seek your support.

For the mission appeal this year, the focus is on one of the social
challenges in their diocese: child basic education. **A pressing
challenge is the prevalence of early marriages among girls;
many are married off at as early as 12 years old, often to
much older men. These girls give birth as early as 13, before
they are physically & mentally mature enough to care for them-
selves or their families.**

**Child marriages infringe upon the fundamental
rights & freedom of young girls & poses a critical issue that
affects their development & well-being.**

**The cost for a girl-child in school for one year, in-
cluding basic needs, is approximately \$500. To support around
600 girl-children from the "peripheries" of our diocese, we need
about \$300,000. Your support will enhance the quality of life in
our society & strengthen the work of evangelization in our dio-
cese. Thank you for your support.**

**LLAMADO MISIONERO 2025
PARA LA DIÓCESIS DE AGULERI, NIGERIA**

El Rev. Fred Ndimaeme, de la Diócesis Católica de Aguleri,
ubicada en el sureste de Nigeria, visitará nuestra parroquia los
días **21 y 22 de junio de 2025** para solicitar su apoyo. El llama-
miento misionero de este año se centra en uno de los desafíos
sociales de su diócesis: la educación básica infantil. **Un prob-
lema apremiante es la prevalencia de matrimonios precoces
entre niñas; muchas se casan a los 12 años, a menudo con
hombres mucho mayores. Estas niñas dan a luz a los 13
años, antes de alcanzar la madurez física y mental suficiente
para cuidar de sí mismas o de sus familias.**

**El matrimonio infantil vulnera los derechos
fundamentales y la libertad de las niñas y plantea un prob-
lema crítico que afecta su desarrollo y bienestar.**

**El costo de escolarización de una niña durante un
año, incluyendo las necesidades básicas, es de aproximad-
amente \$500. Para apoyar a unas 600 niñas de las periferias de
nuestra diócesis, necesitamos unos 300.000 dólares. Su apoyo
mejorará la calidad de vida de nuestra sociedad y fortalecerá la
labor de evangelización en nuestra diócesis. Gracias por su
apoyo.**

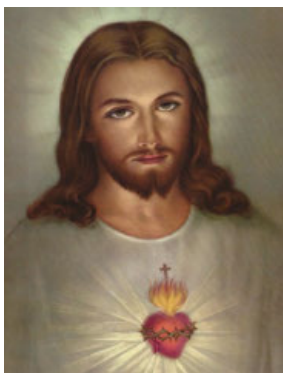
OGŁOSZENIA PARAFIALNE

Baptized in the Trinity

The greatest mystery of our Christian belief is the three persons of the Holy Trinity. Before Christ, man could only conjecture, suspect or hint at the concept of a three person God even when the ancient writings suggested just that. **Gen 1:2, 26, 18:1-2; Ps 2:2-9; Prv 30:4b; Is 6:3; 48:16** The concept of The Trinity only came to light with Jesus Christ, whose person revealed to us a benevolent God, merciful and compassionate to all extents of human understanding, and accepting totally of the human condition. So much so, that He willed His person to become what He created, to suffer with us, and to die with us a most undeservingly painful and humiliating death to show His love for us. God's person became the Incarnation of Jesus the Christ and the man to show us how we are all part of Him. It is not the rocks, the trees, the birds and the beasts that are part of Him, but rather the creation of man in His image. And it doesn't matter how much or little we may have in common with His other creations, it is only man that He has elevated to Himself that all of His other creatures and creations bow to.

Why and how is this creation so special when all its parts are made of elements of the others? The special part comes from the Trinitarian God himself; we are born with the Trinitarian God making up our person. This is unlike any of His other creatures that are unable to know their creator. We are not servants in our charity towards are brethren, but rather brothers and sisters in Christ and heirs to His divinity. **Jn 15:12-15; Rom 8:17**

What does this really mean? Where is the proof and the inheritance? Well, if we are looking for proof, Jesus gives us plenty to consider, as he instructs his disciples through his ministry all the way up to his suffering. **Jn 14:4, 6-7, 9b-17, 20-21**

Okay, but what about the inheritance? The inheritance is eternal life with Him: The Ever-living God. How can we possibly ask for more? If we are seeking wealth, power and carnal pleasures then indeed we have no inheritance with Him, because we seek death, destruction and nothingness.

On the other hand, our one God, the Father through his second person, Jesus Christ, the Son has revealed to us His nature and has made us aware of His existence, love and mercy through His third person, the Holy Spirit: one God -- three persons. **Jn 14:9b-11, 16-17**

Since this revelation, all of Christianity has been born into the world with the knowledge of the Trinitarian God manifested in the human person at conception. **2Pt 1:3-4** All disciples of Christ have the mission to share this mystery so that we may all have an inheritance through Him in Him and with Him, through the unity of the Holy Spirit, in the one living God forever and ever. Amen.

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
