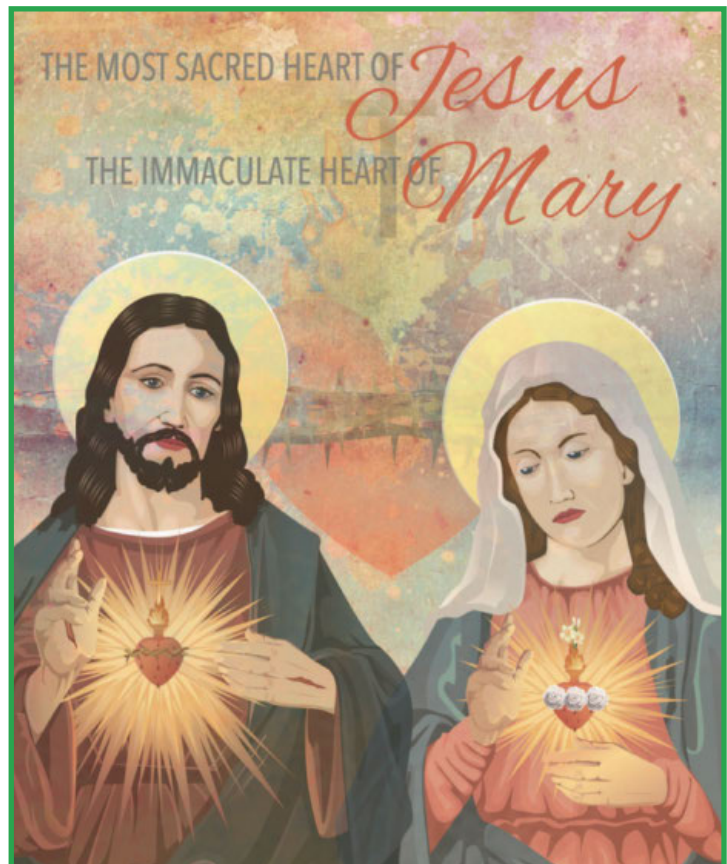

**2025 MISSION APPEAL
FOR AGULERI DIOCESE, NIGERIA**

Rev. Fred Ndimaeme of the Catholic Diocese of Aguleri located in southeastern Nigeria is coming to our parish on **June 21 - 22, 2025** to seek your support. For the mission appeal this year, the focus is on one of the social challenges in their diocese: child basic education. A pressing challenge is the prevalence of early marriages among girls; many are married off at as early as 12 years old, often to much older men. These girls give birth as early as 13, before they are physically & mentally mature enough to care for themselves or their families.



Child marriages infringe upon the fundamental rights & freedom of young girls & poses a critical issue that affects their development & well-being.

The cost for a girl-child in school for one year, including basic needs, is approximately \$500. To support around 600 girl-children from the "peripheries" of our diocese, we need about \$300,000. Your support will enhance the quality of life in our society & strengthen the work of evangelization in our diocese. Thank you for your support.

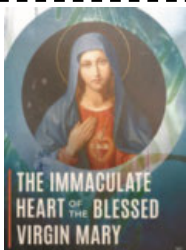


en uno de los desafíos sociales de su diócesis: la educación básica infantil. Un problema apremiante es la prevalencia de matrimonios precoces entre niñas; muchas se casan a los 12 años, a menudo con hombres mucho mayores. Estas niñas dan a luz

a los 13 años, antes de alcanzar la madurez física y mental suficiente para cuidar de sí mismas o de sus familias.

El matrimonio infantil vulnera los derechos fundamentales y la libertad de las niñas y plantea un problema crítico que afecta su desarrollo y bienestar.

El costo de escolarización de una niña durante un año, incluyendo las necesidades básicas, es de aproximadamente \$500. Para apoyar a unas 600 niñas de las periferias de nuestra diócesis, necesitamos unos 300.000 dólares. Su apoyo mejorará la calidad de vida de nuestra sociedad y fortalecerá la labor de evangelización en nuestra diócesis. Gracias por su apoyo.

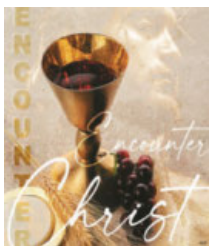

A Sunday Reflection

“Jesus said, ‘I am the living bread that came down from Heaven; whoever eats this bread will live forever; ... Amen, amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have [eternal] life within you.’” Jn 6:51, 53



The Mystery of the Body of Christ: the words embody so much symbolically, as well as physically. The Church communities, which include all the faithful united by Communion in the one Body of Christ (**1Cor12:12-14, 27**), The Cross with the Corpus to symbolize every human person's physical body of sins nailed to it in the form of the Body of Christ (**Jn 19:34; 1Pt 2:24**), The Eucharist as the life-giving entity both physically as bread and wine and spiritually in the form of the Body and Blood of Christ (**Jn 6:53**) all make up the one Body of Christ as in The Trinity.

When Jesus instructs Nicodemus on the re-birth in the Trinity through water, His blood and the Spirit that leads to the Kingdom of God (**Jn 3:5; 1Jn 5:6-8**); it is the physical manifestation of this action of The Sacred Body and Blood of Jesus Christ, Son of God that becomes our ‘bread of life’ in The Holy Eucharist.

By these acts we are re-born and receive God's total love for humanity from Easter to Pentecost and our inheritance in the one true living God of Hosts: the act of Baptism, the act of The Holy Eucharist and the act of Confirmation; the three are of one accord.

This is the Holy Mass instituted by Jesus at the Last Supper. In going to Mass, we are truly heirs to His love and likeness through our own free will. We baptize ourselves at the Holy Water font with Holy Water and receive the Liturgy of the Word from the ambo. We conclude our learning of His teaching with the recitation of the Credo, when we profess our faith. Having prepared our bodies to be receptive to grace by good deeds we have performed, and cleansing our souls through the sacrament of reconciliation, we become one body in Christ (**1Jn 5:12**). Together with the spiritual offerings of the form of bread and wine, the celebrant's offering and ours are transformed by Jesus to His Body and Blood. In the Consecration of the Holy Eucharist, Jesus offers up His life for ours to the Father. In a State of Grace, we partake in the Sacrificial Banquet of the Eucharist, while the Father sends down His acceptance of our offering in the act of confirmation by His Holy Spirit. This act of Communion with the Holy Trinity is the Holy Mass, and the supernatural re-birth in faith by water, blood and spirit; a Communion in the Name of The Father, and of The Son and of The Holy Ghost. **“Amen, I say to you, unless you eat the flesh of the Son of Man and drink His blood, you do not have [eternal] life within you.” Jn 6:53**

It is our free will to be part of God's love for mankind in the Holy Mass, the true presence of His Son, Jesus Christ. Amen.
