

Dear Brothers and Sisters in Christ

I hope this letter finds you and your family healthy and happy as we continue through the summer months. Today, I write to ask you to consider making a gift to the National Combined Collection. The National Combined Collection contributes to the Retirement Fund for Religious, Catholic University of America, Catholic Communications Campaign, and Peter's Pence and will take place in our parishes the weekend of **September 3 & 4, 2022**. 


