Catholics are encouraged to makes spiritual communion. St. John Paul II writes that "it is good to cultivate in our hearts a constant desire for the sacrament of the Eucharist. This was the origin of the practice of 'spiritual communion', which has happily been established in the Church for centuries and recommended by saints who were masters of the spiritual life. Saint Teresa of Jesus wrote: 'When you do not receive communion and you do not attend Mass, you can make a spiritual communion, which is a most beneficial practice; by it the love of God will be greatly impressed on you." (Ecclesia de Eucharistia, no. 34)

Begin a time of prayer with the sign of the cross

- Take time to read and reflect upon the readings from Sunday Mass. The readings are available at usccb.org and a Sunday Gospel reflection can be found at the same website or at dioceseofprovidence.org
- Share prayer intentions quietly or aloud.
- Pray the Lord's Prayer.
- Pray the following prayer of spiritual communion.

My Jesus, I believe that You are present I n the Most Holy Sacrament. I love You above all things, and I desire to receive You into my soul. Since I cannot at this moment receive You sacramentally, come at least spiritually into my heart. I embrace You as if You were already there and unite myself wholly to You. Never permit me to be separated from You. Amen.





The three sad days are quickly sped; He rises glorious from the dead; All glory to our risen Head: Alleluia!


He closed the yawning gates of hell; The bars from heav'n's high portals fell; Let hymns of praise His triumphs tell: Alleluia!
