FROM THE PASTOR

I want to thank everyone for your prayers for my recovery from Covid, I continue to feel better, and hopefully will be “up and running” like I usually am around here, by the time you read this! For those of you who didn’t know I caught Covid three weeks ago, I’m putting below what I said at Mass last Sunday.

Thank you also to everyone who has donated so far to this year’s Annual Parish Appeal, which we mailed out to all parishioners in mid December. As of January 15, this year’s Appeal has raised \$33,000. Our Appeal Goal this year is \$45,000, and it’s not too late at all to give: any donation large or small will be greatly appreciated and will be used towards the day to day operational expenses of the parish. A reminder that in addition to using the return Appeal Envelope, parishioners can also give securely online by visiting our Parish Website stjohnpaulri.com and clicking the Appeal link under “Parish Giving.”

Speaking of fund raisers, our school is getting ready for it’s biggest fund raiser and social event of the year, it’s Annual Silent/Live Auction, which this year will feature an in person Dinner and Live Auction at the Quonset O Club on Saturday Evening, March 26, as well as a Livestream Silent Auction Kickoff Event one week prior to the Auction. As you know, last year we were able to complete our outdoor sport court project with the Auction Proceeds; this year, we are raising funds to start a new multi year project: the renovation of our classrooms with new desks and chairs. The School will be starting to ask for various donations for the Auction in the weeks to come (see elsewhere in this week’s bulletin for this week’s announcement and the link to their online wish board), and a lot more info on the Auction will be coming soon here in the bulletin and on our parish social media, so stay tuned!

Fr. Woolley’s Announcement before Mass Last Sunday January 16

In case you haven’t heard, I joined the club: on Monday January 3, I tested positive for Covid.

I started feeling run down on Sunday January 2, but I thought it was just that I was wiped out from the back to back New Years and Sunday Masses (I did five big Masses and a Wake Service over the course of 48 hours) at the end of the very busy Advent and Christmas Season, and when I took a rapid test that Sunday afternoon, I was negative. On Monday January 3 I was still wiped out, and that afternoon, the rapid was positive, and a PCR I took that day also came back positive. While I’m fully vaccinated, got a booster shot a month ago, and hadn’t been going to any small gatherings, I think it was because I was so run down that I caught it.

Thankfully, because I tested negative on the rapid Sunday afternoon, I most probably wasn’t contagious when I celebrated the weekend Masses, and thankfully I wasn’t in close contact with Fr. Doan or with anyone on Monday that wasn’t fully vaccinated, as far as I know.

My symptoms have thankfully been very mild; I never had a fever, lost my taste or smell, and had just mild head cold symptoms that didn’t go away much until yesterday. Although I still have a cough and some lingering fatigue, according to the health experts I’m well out of the contagious period of 10 days.

I want to thank Fr. Doan who really stepped up to the plate and did mostly all of the Masses and funerals these past two weeks. I made sure that I stayed far away from him in the rectory, and I put on my fitted N95 mask that I use to anoint covid patients with, on the rare occasions I went out of my room during my contagious period.

So, that’s what’s been going on with me lately, please keep me in your prayers, I don’t need any chicken soup or anything, just the prayers that I continue to get my strength back, and that I don’t come down with long covid. Thanks!

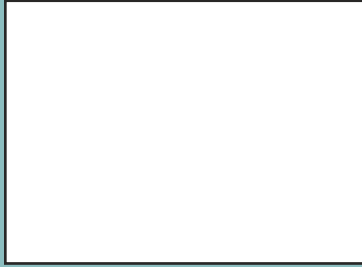

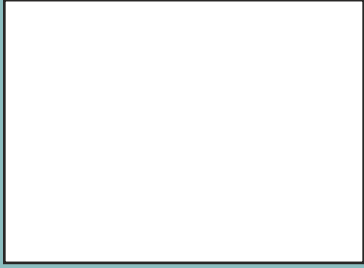


