
Prayer Fellowship


Attention Lectors!

From the Pastor

Fr. Dennis Kieton, a senior priest of our diocese, moved into Fr. JD's old room at the rectory this past week; he will be helping out with the Masses and the other sacraments.

Fr. Kieton was ordained in 1985 by Bishop Gelineau, after having been previously for many years a Religious Brother. His first assignment as a priest was - guess where? right here at Ss. John and Paul in Coventry (he was actually one of my favorite priests growing up, I'm sure a lot of you remember him being here with Fr. Doyle and Fr. Kiley in the mid to late 80s).

Fr. Kieton went on to serve as Pastor for 15 years at Our Lady of Fatima Parish in Cumberland, and also as Pastor of Holy Ghost and Our Lady of Mt.
