the less fortunate of our community. Donations from the poor boxes go to fund this ministry. Last week we collected \$78.00




SS. JOHN AND PAUL'S CHRISTMAS GIVING TREE


These young men had their Eagle Scout Court of Honor this past weekend. They each earned their Eagle Scout Rank, which is the highest advancement rank in Boy Scouting.



From the Pastor The Biggest Parish in the Diocese just got a LITTLE bigger!



"This land is your land; This land is my land;
'Cause the parish just bought it; From the state of Rhode Island;
We're gonna put a sign here, If the town will let us,
This land's now owned by SSJP!"

This past week, with approval from the Diocese of Providence, the Parish Trustees, and the Finance Committee, our parish purchased from the Rhode Island Department of Transportation an approximately 2000 square foot parcel of land, on the island of grass in front of our of our parish, diagonally across from Gelinas Ice Cream (the island has on it a tree, a fire hydrant and a telephone pole, and four stakes in the ground currently show the borders of the parcel purchased). We've been actually trying to purchase this land for the past three and a half years, but various issues with surveying arose, causing such a long delay. The land was paid for by a bequest in loving memory of Irene Sarachman, by parishioners William and Merylene Emmett.

Our reason for purchasing the land is to install in the near future a permanent sign on the property, to advertise our parish and school events. You might be asking "Father, couldn't we put a sign on the property we already own?" The problem with that is, most of the lawn in front of the Church closest to the street is owned by the state, due to South Main St. and Tiogue Ave being reconfigured about 20 years ago, so to put a sign on the property we own would make it too far back from the road to be of any use; but the land we just purchased will be very visible to the traffic going by. The next step will be asking the Town of Coventry for a variance in order to put a sign up. About four years ago, we checked with the town zoning board and told them our plans, and they told us we probably wouldn't have an issue getting a variance; however, you can't apply for a variance on land you don't own! But now that we own it, we'll be applying for one. As I've been trying for almost four years to buy this land for the parish, I'm very happy we finally own it, small as it is. And while it took a long time, I'm thankful to the good people who work at RIDOT for their assistance in purchasing the land: RIDOT waived every fee for us, and even did some of the surveying work that we should have been responsible for. Thanks so much! Now, please pray to the "Land Lord" of our Parish, Jesus, that we can one day have a sign out there, welcoming people to our parish and school, and advertising all the great things we have going on here!
