


Thank you for your continued support of the Our Daily Bread program. Your support helps to feed the less fortunate of our community.


Help Request for Our Homeless!

As the colder weather approaches, our homeless are in need of hand and feet warmers, hats, gloves, socks, dry shampoo, baby wipes and bottled water.






