
### Help Request for Our Homeless!



## Fr. Joseph Henry, Rest in Peace!

Fr. Joseph Henry, Pastor Emeritus of Ss. John and Paul Parish, Coventry, passed away Thursday, March 2, at age 90.

Fr. Henry became Pastor of our parish in 1989 when Fr. Doyle retired, and served until his own retirement in 2003, he was very well loved by the parishioners.

During his time here, Fr. Henry built the Rectory residence (which he paid for with the interest from the savings Fr. Doyle had in the bank, Fr. Doyle never spent a dime!), and doubled the classroom size of the school building, by adding the middle school wing onto the school. He also loved the color blue, and had the wall in back of the Crucifix and altar painted the beautiful blue that we have today.

Fr. Henry was very athletic, he was a good skier, and played Racquetball religiously every week with his good friend Fr. Wil Gregiore up into his 80s. He was also a big URI Rams basketball fan, and attended a lot of their home games. Fr. Henry had a very dignified but fatherly manner to him, he was always visiting the sick, and in his retirement, he became very involved in Prison Ministry, and also helped out at St. Thomas More Parish.

Fr. Henry came to our parish when Fr. Woolley was in college, and in many ways he inspired both him and fellow parishioner Fr. Chris Mahar to become priests. He was a great Priest and Pastor, and we were very blessed to have him at our parish.

Fr. Henry was waked at St. Veronica Chapel in Narragansett Sunday afternoon March 5 from 4-6pm, and his Mass of Christian Burial was 11am Monday March 6 at St. Thomas More Church Narragansett. Funeral arrangements were handled by Barrett and Cotter Funeral Home in Warwick.
