As we enter the Income Tax season, please be aware that **all monetary donations to SVdP are TAX DEDUCTABLE** as we are a 501c-3 charity!


We are in need of a gently used/new freezer to assist in our distribution of Family Food Boxes for those in need here in town. If you have one that you wish to donate, please call or email us!
