


#### **SPONSORSHIP:**







## Mass Intentions Book for 2024 The Mass Book for 2024 will open on Monday, October 2.

Please come on or after that day to book Masses. Until November 1, there will be a limit of 1 Sunday/Holy Day Mass and 1 Weekday Mass that can be booked, so that everyone will have a chance to get Masses offered for their intentions. Sunday are \$25 offering, weekday Masses are \$10; these offerings are set by the diocese.

We also have the Sanctuary (Tabernacle) Lamps (in both the Church and the Chapel) or the Altar Candles (in both the Church and the Chapel) that can be burned in loving memory of a deceased loved one, or for some other intention, for the period of one week, for an offering of \$10 each. There is still availability in this year's Mass book for intentions.




