

FROM THE PASTOR

Introducing the Chanted Entrance Antiphons for Sundays in Advent

This past February, I was visiting a priest friend of mine in Vermont one weekend, and his parish did something at their Sunday Masses that made me say "We should try doing that at St John and Paul." And this Advent, we are trying it!

Starting next Sunday, and for all four Sundays in Advent, at the 5pm, 7:30am and 9:30am Masses, the Mass will begin with a brief "pre-processional" chanted Entrance Antiphon before the opening Hymn. The Entrance Antiphon is a short scripture verse that may be used in place of an opening Hymn to begin the Mass. Like the Sunday Readings and Opening and Closing Prayers, these Entrance Antiphons are proper to the Sunday Masses (in other words, there's a different and unique Entrance Antiphon for every Sunday and Solemnity of the Liturgical Year). Those who attend Daily Mass should be very familiar with these Entrance Antiphons, as they are normally recited by the priest and congregation at the start of each Daily Mass instead of an opening Hymn.


The original Latin versions of these Sunday Entrance Antiphons all have traditional musical settings to them, many of which were composed over a thousand years ago, and which have been continually chanted in many Churches each year for centuries, down to our present day. Recently, there has been a movement in the Church to bring back in parishes the custom of chanting these Entrance Antiphons, either in their original Latin or translated into the current Church approved English translation. Particularly, in 2015, a Benedictine Priest named Fr. Samuel Weber painstakingly set the English translations of all the Sunday Entrance Antiphons to Gregorian Chant, trying to stay as close as possible to the original Latin Chant. It was Fr. Weber's versions of these Antiphons that I heard at my priest friend's Parish in Vermont, and so I bought a copy of Fr. Weber's book for our Parish to use.

So, what will be different? While I've taken a lot of time to explain these chanted Entrance Antiphons, the Antiphons themselves usually take only about 30-45 seconds to sing! And so, for the four Sundays of Advent, when the bell is rung to start the Mass, the congregation will stand up as usual, but the servers and clergy will remain standing in the back of the Church while this Entrance Antiphon is chanted by our organist. Parishioners can actually follow along silently, as these Entrance Antiphons are found in the Breaking Bread Missalettes, right before the First Reading of the

Mass of that Sunday (see photo). Once the Entrance Antiphon chant is finished, the organist will then announce as usual "our opening hymn is number such and such, etc." and the Servers and Priest will process down the aisle, and the Mass will continue as usual.

I'm excited to introduce these Entrance Antiphons for a number of reasons. First, the Chant settings are beautiful, and really "set the tone" for the Mass, helping us enter into worship. Secondly, Gregorian chant is kind of the "official soundtrack" to the Roman Catholic Mass, for centuries it has spiritually nourished the faithful, and helped to raise their hearts and minds to the Lord at Mass. As I have said in the past, I believe that there should be a place for both the horizontal, human dimension, and the vertical, divine dimension in the liturgy, and I think celebrating Mass with a mixture of traditional music (hymns and chants) and more contemporary music helps to achieve this balance (for this reason, I don't envision these Entrance Antiphons taking the place of the Opening Hymn at our parish, as is done at some parishes; like my friend's parish in Vermont, I think its best to add them as a brief "pre-processional" addition, prior to the Opening Hymn). Lastly, as the Entrance Antiphon and its chanted musical setting is proper to each Sunday Mass throughout the Liturgical Year, one becomes familiar with these chants as they are heard year after year, and one starts

to look forward to hearing them — as, for example, one looks forward to hearing favorite Christmas Carols or Easter hymns at Mass each year.

So, please let me know what you think about these Entrance Antiphon once the Four Sundays of Advent are over; if they seem to go over well, I'm thinking we can do them each year for the Seasons of Advent and Lent, to add to the prayerfulness and specialness of these two Holy Seasons!
