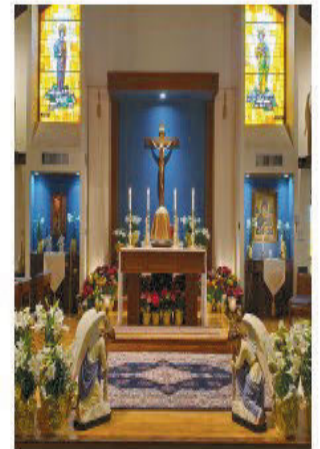

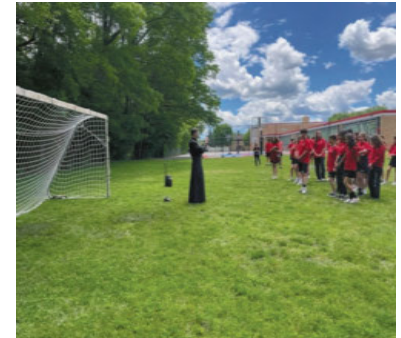

On Wednesday, May 29th, Fr. Woolley blessed our newly installed 7' x 21' soccer goals in the field behind the school, completing the Field Renovation Project that was begun last Fall. In late November, we installed an irrigation system which is hooked up to the irrigation well that waters the front school lawns. Then in early December, we installed two 12' x 40' backstops with mesh netting, to keep the balls from going into the woods. Next, we overseeded the lawn in February; and finally, we installed the goals, which were given by the Coventry Soccer Association in exchange for the use of our school gym for their Futsal program this past winter. The Field Renovation Project was funded by this year's Walk a Thon and Alumni Appeal, thank you to all who donated to these fundraisers, for enabling us to achieve our "goals"!
