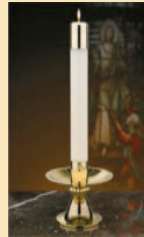

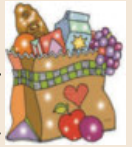

From the Pastor

On October 31, Archbishop Henning will be installed Archbishop of the Archdiocese of Boston, and our Diocese of Providence will be without a Bishop. At that time, the College of Consultors—a body of priests from our Diocese established by canon law—will elect an Apostolic Administrator to continue the administration of the Diocese of Providence, until such time as the Holy Father appoints a new Bishop of Providence (a Priest or Bishop can serve as Apostolic Administrator, but not a lay person). Appointing the next Bishop of Providence is the sole prerogative of the Holy Father, Pope Francis.

I am asking all parishioners to join me in the Novena Prayer for a New Bishop below, beginning this Wednesday October 23 to October 31, or if you are able to, until we get a new Bishop. The Novena Prayer is a literal translation of the Prayer for the Election of a New Pope from the 1962 Roman Missal, modified for our Diocese, and I also added the “for years to come” line, so that we’ll be praying that this new Bishop the Lord sends us doesn’t get taken away prematurely from us again!
