

From the Pastor

Heat Pumps now firing on all pistons! The Church Heating/Air Conditioning Project is now finally completed, and the unit is up and running in heat mode. So far its been working great; even a few weeks ago when it was 19 degrees Fahrenheit out, it still kept the Church at 67 degrees without the oil boiler kicking on! We installed this system mainly because our air conditioning system was on its last legs, with only two of the five obsolete outdoor units still functioning, and the other three broken ones unable to be repaired. Because of an incentive the State of Rhode Island was offering, it ended up being cheaper to install a system that not only cooled but also provided efficient heating down to 0 degrees F, as the project was eligible for a \$56,000 rebate! The 24 ton, three phase VRF Toshiba/Carrier system should save the parish on heating expenses, as heat pumps cost less to heat than oil with normal electrical rates; however, we will save even more, because we receive solar net metering credits as we've contracted with Green Energy through the St. Joseph Cemetery Solar Farm in West Greenwich, and our electricity rates are currently locked in from three years ago, also thanks to the Diocese who got a good price on energy for all its institutions through a broker. Its also possible that the more efficient system will save us on air conditioning costs in the summer months. As we've been working on getting these heat pumps in since last January, I'm really happy to see them finally installed! God bless, Fr. Woolley

FROM THE PASTOR


Each year, parish corporations are required by state law to publish a summary of its financial report to its parishioners. At the doors of the Church this Sunday is summary of our Parish's financial report for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024; parishioners can also obtain a copy of the report at the Rectory. Below is the text of my letter which accompanies the one page financial summary. God bless, Fr. Woolley

December 15, 2024 Third Sunday of Advent Dear Ss. John and Paul Parishioners:

The Peace of Christ be with you. On the reverse of this sheet, please find the Parish's financial report for the fiscal year beginning July 1, 2023 and ending June 30, 2024.

Thanks to a continued increase in Sunday Mass attendance and new parishioners, combined with a successful Increased Giving Sunday appeal last February, our weekly budget collection was up \$20,295 from last year, a 3% increase; in addition, our income from fund raising, the annual appeal, bequests and rentals was also up \$38,931 from last year, a 23% increase. Due to inflation and Fr. Doan finally getting back from Vietnam in mid June 2023 after being stuck there for a year, expenses were up \$83,559.91, not factoring in depreciation expenses, a 13% increase. Despite the increased expenses outweighing the increase in income, the parish still ended the year \$135,280.99 in the black, after deducting the parish's subsidy to the school, and not factoring in depreciation expenses.

We continue to be very grateful to God that the school keeps growing and getting more financially secure! While enrollment stayed at a healthy 204 students in 2023/24 from the previous year, tuition revenue increased \$80,736.99 from the previous year, and total operating income also increased by \$87,135, while expenditures increased only \$26,061.53, not

factoring in depreciation expenses. As a result, the parish subsidy to the school continued to remain at a very sustainable level.

We are almost halfway through this new 2024/25 fiscal year, and things are looking very well — the Sunday collection is currently up 8% from this time last year, and our income is well meeting our budgetary needs. This is due to the generosity of you faithful long time parishioners, as well as you many new parishioners who have joined our parish over the past several months from parishes in the area that are sadly closing; we hope all you new parishioners continue to feel more and more at home in our parish!

Things are also looking very well at the school these days — we started up a third pre-K classroom this 2024/25 Academic year, and it was filled to capacity by the start of school! In addition to the 16 students in the new pre-K, we also gained nine more students in K to 8, putting our total school enrollment at 229 students at the start of the school year! Currently, our three pre-K's, our Kindergarten and our First Grade classes are full, and these classes are filling up fast for the 2025/26 school year, thanks to the Lord and our school's patron saints answering our prayers, and to the outstanding work our Principal Kevin Peloquin and our school teachers and staff members are doing at our school!

As always, if anyone has questions regarding this report, please don't hesitate to ask. I wish to thank our business manager, Renée Johnson, our Finance Committee, Trustees and Parish Auditors for their assistance in preparing this report. Finally, I wish to especially thank the many parishioners and school parents who generously support our parish and school with their time, talent and treasure.
