# **Coventry Food Bank**





# A Message from Fr. Woolley and Mr. Peloquin This Month's Second Collection for the School Will Go Towards the FJVD Annual Appeal Fund

Dear Parishioners,

As you know, our parish has a Second Collection one Sunday a month throughout the year for the needs of Fr. John V. Doyle School. This monthly collection helps the school pay for day to day operational expenses, such as salaries, school supplies, and utilities bills, while at the same time helping us keep school tuition down to an affordable level for parents. We are very grateful to all of you who generously give to this monthly second collection!

The parish and school have decided that, going forward, once a year, this monthly school collection will go towards the Father John V. Doyle School's Annual Appeal Fund instead of the school's general fund. All the other eleven monthly school collections will continue to go towards the school's operational expenses.

We began this Annual School Appeal six years ago, which begins every November with an appeal letter we send to all of our school's alumni (a large alumni database was compiled about 8 years ago that we have continued to update), and ends on June 30, the end of our fiscal year. Through the generosity of our Alumni and other benefactors, the Annual School Appeal has raised over \$265,000 since November of 2018, and has funded \$200,000 worth of projects, including converting the schools oil boiler to natural gas (at a fuel savings of about \$15,000 a year), upgrading our schools phone system (also at a cost savings of over \$2000 a year), providing the "start up" funds needed to purchase everything needed for our new 3rd Pre-K classroom (which began the school year at capacity), renovating the back field and back playground, renovating and upgrading office spaces and the teacher's lounge, installing security cameras inside the school, painting the hallway ceilings, installing an irrigation well and sprinkler system for all the school lawns, and much more. All funds raised by the Annual Appeal are held in a separate savings account, and are only used for projects like these. With funds from this year's Appeal, we hope to among other things purchase new cafeteria tables that can convert into benches, and a new AED for the school gym.

This Sunday, January 11-12, your contribution in the monthly school second collection will go to this 2024-2025 FJVD Annual Appeal. Please note, this isn't an extra collection for the school, but the usual monthly school collection (that those of you who receive budgets have an envelope for), just earmarked for a different purpose this one time out of the year. And once again, thank you for your continued generosity to our school, it is a big reason why Fr. Doyle continues to prosper and move forward!
