

SSJP Young Adult Group Hits the Ice!
Ice Bumper Car Outing at Providence Rink, Wednesday February 5, 2025

Our Young Adult Group is taking a trip to the Providence Rink in Downtown Providence, Wednesday February 5! We have reserved 16 ice bumper cars: 8 cars from 7:20pm to 7:40pm and 8 cars from 7:40pm to 8:00pm (only 8 cars at a time on the ice, one person per car, 15 minute session) for Wednesday, February 5, 2025.

As we need to find a place to park, and be at the rink 15 minutes ahead of time, to be on the safe side we will need to leave the Church parking lot at 6:15pm (or you can meet us there).

The cost to ride the Bumper Cars is \$10 a person (discount rate, the parish will pay the remainder). Afterwards, those who are interested can go skating on the ice rink (or you can buy a hot cocoa and hang out and watch the skaters); for those who want to skate, the cost is \$5 a person (discount rate, parish will pick up the rest), bring your own skates, or its \$8.41 to rent skates at the rink.

****PLEASE NOTE: As there's only 16 cars reserved (the max number we could get in that time frame), please call Fr. Woolley at the Rectory 821-5764 to let him know you want to attend, and we'll reserve a bumper car for you.



We will soon be training new candidates who would like to become altar servers at Ss. John and Paul.


You must have already made your First Holy Communion, be currently in the fourth grade or over, and be a parishioner of Ss. John and Paul.
