



#### Lenten Regulations Fridays in Lent – Days of <u>Abstinence</u>

• All Catholics 14 and over are to abstain from meat.

• Those who are sick or must do heavy manual labor may dispense themselves from this obligation.

#### Every day of Lent (excluding Sundays) is a Day of <u>Penance</u>

• Catholics of all ages should do *at least one* act of Penance (Prayer, Fasting, or Almsgiving) each day of this Holy Season in atonement for one's sins and in remembrance of Jesus' Forty Day fast in the desert when He was tempted by Satan.

We ask also that the candy not be produced in a facility where other nut containing products are made,


