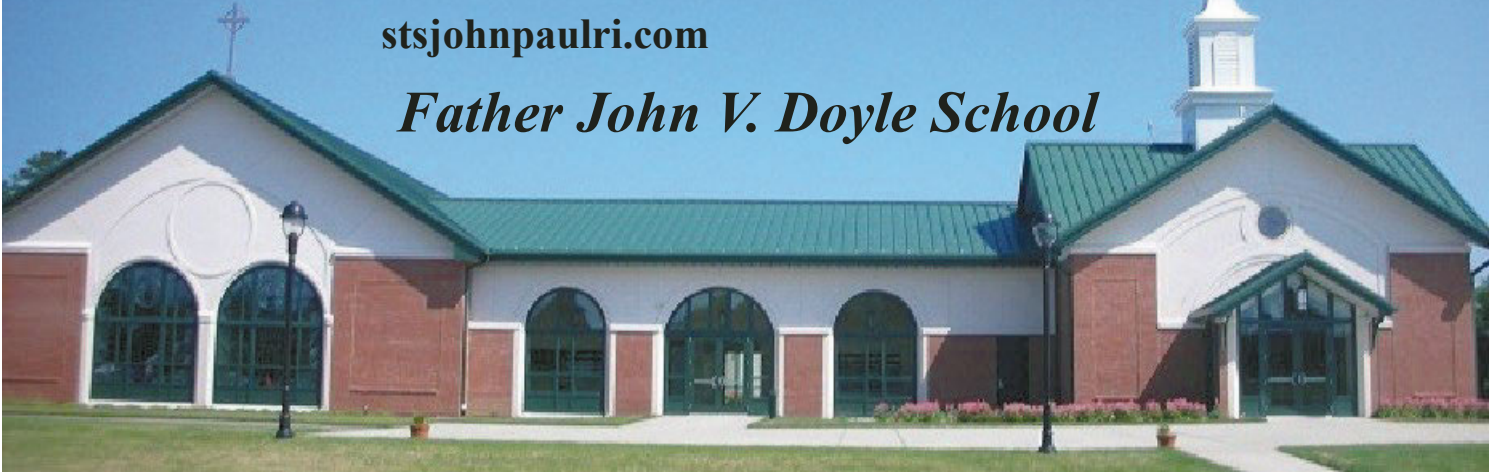

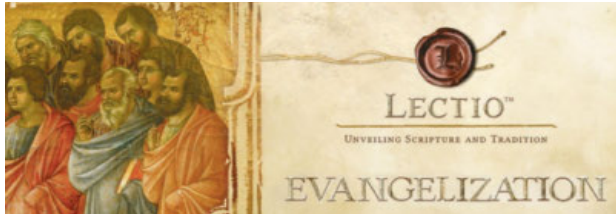
**Our Daily Bread**

**Lenten Regulations**

**Fridays in Lent – Days of Abstinence**

- All Catholics 14 and over are to abstain from meat.
- Those who are sick or must do heavy manual labor may dispense themselves from this obligation.

**Every day of Lent (excluding Sundays) is a Day of Penance**

- Catholics of all ages should do *at least one* act of Penance (Prayer, Fasting, or Almsgiving) each day of this Holy Season in atonement for one’s sins and in remembrance of Jesus’ Forty Day fast in the desert when He was tempted by Satan.

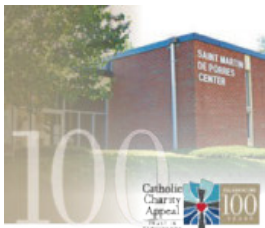

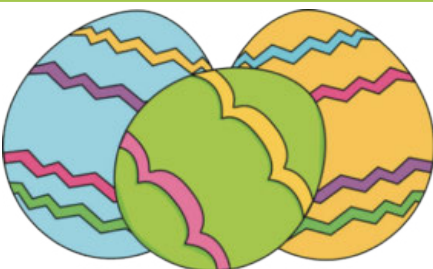
**Coventry Food Bank**

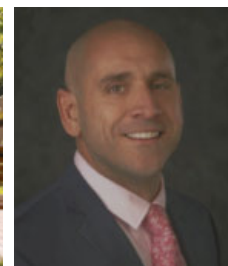
