Following the Russian invasion of the country in the early hours of Feb 24, the capital city of Kyiv and the eastern city of Kharkiv were targeted with attacks that quickly spread across central and eastern areas of Ukraine. These attacks displaced people from their homes, especially in cities and towns in the east. Both the Pontifical Mission Societies, which are the pope's charities, and Catholic Relief Services, the official international humanitarian agency of the Catholic community in the United States, are working to help the Ukrainian people. 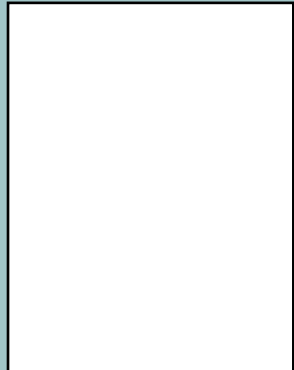

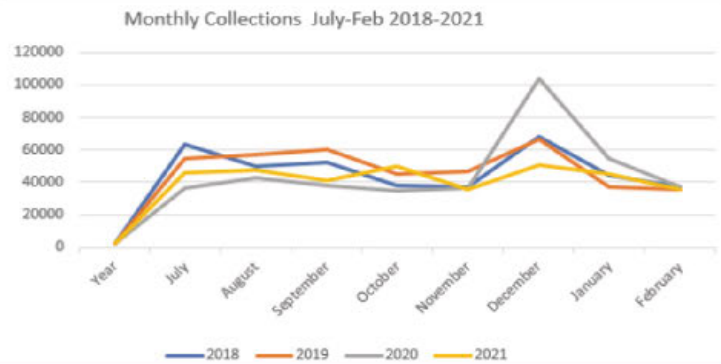
