NEW GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS

As of June 6, 2021 the celebration of Holy Mass will return to Thursday, June 17th - Ferial Weekday normal following these guidelines:

- Masks are optional and may be worn at the discretion of each individual. Those who have not been vaccinated are strongly encouraged to continue to wear masks.
- Seating at our discretion will continue to 2) accommodate those who feel it is beneficial to have social distancing.
- Those who are ill and infirm are dispensed from 3) attendance at Mass and should only attend when well or with proper assistance.
- Bringing up the offertory gifts remains suspended. 4)

- 6) The distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended.



Last Saturday evening, (June 5th), the Vigil of Corpus Christi, I joined about 3,000 virtual participants as we joined the in-person participants of Franciscan University's Power and Purpose Conference. The evening began with praise and worship music, continued with an hour's inspirational talk, and concluded with Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament. It was wonderful to participate in the event and to see actual people "in the pews" joining in the festival of praise to the Lord. Such times of prayer restore the joy of our youth!

This week I will be going to the same venue; Franciscan University of Steubenville, for their annual Priests, Deacons, and Seminarians Conference/Retreat. It is part of the university's long charism of calling priests to gather for a week of prayer, praise and worship, and spiritual talks. In the early days (the mid 1970's), the priests gathered under a tent in the spirit of a Tent Revival! Today, we gather in the comfort of an air conditioned Field House. Nonetheless, it is an experience of climbing God's Holy Mountain to leave earthly cares and tasks to focus on the better portion; the Glory the Lord desires for His people.

It will be my 15th Conference, and my experience is that the most recent conference is always better than the ones before it! The goodness of the Lord never gets old, but like choice wine, gets better with age!

This month of June is the month of the Sacred Heart; and in a way the month to pray for priests who bring us the graces of the Sacred Heart through the Eucharist and Confession. As we enter into Summer; let us pray for the priests of Manchester that they may experience the rest from labors which Jesus offers through the confines of His Heart. Even though the burden is heavy; in the Lord it is always light!


