**NEW GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS**

As of June 6, 2021 the celebration of Holy Mass will return to normal following these guidelines:

- 1) Masks are optional and may be worn at the discretion of each individual. Those who have not been vaccinated are strongly encouraged to continue to wear masks.
- 2) Seating at our discretion will continue to accommodate those who feel it is beneficial to have social distancing.
- 3) Those who are ill and infirm are dispensed from attendance at Mass and should only attend when well or with proper assistance.
- 4) Bringing up the offertory gifts remains suspended.
- 5) The exchange of the Sign of Peace remains suspended.
- 6) The distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended.

A Meditation - By Henri Nouwen

I know that true joy comes from letting God love me the way God wants, whether it is through illness or health, failure or success, poverty or wealth, rejection or praise. It is hard for me to say, "I shall gratefully accept everything, Lord, that pleases you. Let your will be done." But I know that when I truly believe my Father is pure love, it will become increasingly possible to say these words from the heart.

Charles de Foucauld once wrote a prayer of abandonment that expresses beautifully the spiritual attitude I wish I had.

Father, I abandon myself into your hands,  
do with me what you will.  
Whatever you may do, I thank you;  
I am ready for all, I accept all.  
Let only your will be done in me, and in all your creatures.

I wish no more than this, O Lord.

Into your hands I commend my soul;  
I offer it to you with all the love of my heart,  
for I love you, Lord, and so need to give myself,  
to surrender myself into your hands without reserve,  
and with boundless confidence, for you are my Father.

It seems good to pray this prayer often. These are words of a holy man, and they show the way I must go. I realize that I can never make this prayer come true by my own efforts. But the Spirit of Jesus given to me can help me pray it and grow to its fulfillment. I know that my inner peace depends on my willingness to make this prayer my own.

August is the month dedicated to the Immaculate Heart of Mary. For St. Joseph Church, we were gifted in the last year with a statue of the Sacred Heart, its repairing and preparation for painting, and the painting itself, and with the little altar for the statue to rest. On the left side of the church, it is my hope, I've been searching!!, to add a statue of the Immaculate Heart of Mary. At the very least, we will add a statue to honor our Blessed Mother under one of her many glorious titles. For St. Anthony Church, we are planning an outdoor memorial dedicated to Our Lady and seeking her protection for the unborn and asking her prayers of mercy for those who have died in the womb. It is under the mantle of Our Lady, "to thee do we come, before thee we stand, sinful and sorrowful," that we ask her protection for us as a Christian people on our pilgrim journey to the Father's House.


Today, we celebrate our Catholic belief that at the end of her earthly life, Our Lady was Assumed (not her own power, but by the power of her son) into heaven to share immediately in the Resurrected life of Christ. She lives this life in a risen, glorified body that did not experience any of the natural decay associated with death. This was celebrated in ancient times

as Mary's Dormition, falling asleep, with the emphasis that she was not deceased, but gone to live with the Lord. On the octave day of her Assumption, the 22<sup>nd</sup> of August, we celebrate her Queenship. She is in heaven as the Queen Mother where she sits at the right hand of the King, Christ Jesus, and intercedes for us before His throne of Mercy.

On this August 22<sup>nd</sup>, as it falls on a Sunday, we celebrate at St. Anthony the anniversary of the church's dedication as a House of Worship. As we did last year celebrating the 50<sup>th</sup> anniversary of St. Joseph Church's dedication, this special feast takes precedence over a Sunday of Ordinary Time. We render thanks to God for all the holy souls who have entered through the church's portals to celebrate the divine mysteries and pray that this place may always be a House for the Lord's flock to gather and to be nourished.
