**NEW GUIDELINES FOR ATTENDING MASS**

As of June 6, 2021 the celebration of Holy Mass will return to normal following these guidelines:

- 1) Masks are optional and may be worn at the discretion of each individual. Those who have not been vaccinated are strongly encouraged to continue to wear masks.
- 2) Seating at our discretion will continue to accommodate those who feel it is beneficial to have social distancing.
- 3) Those who are ill and infirm are dispensed from attendance at Mass and should only attend when well or with proper assistance.
- 4) Bringing up the offertory gifts remains suspended.
- 5) The exchange of the Sign of Peace remains suspended.
- 6) The distribution of the Precious Blood remains suspended.

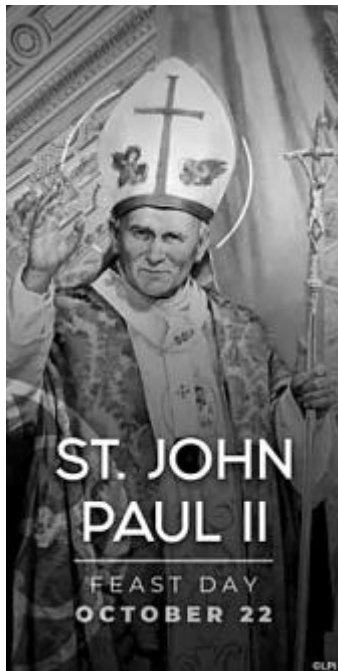


### SACRAMENT OF ANOINTING OF THE SICK

As we approach November, the month in which we dedicate our prayers for the repose of the souls of the faithful departed, one of the great turnarounds we have experienced in this parish are the blessings of Mass Intentions!! When I arrived here 6.5 years ago, I had to create Mass intentions and ask for intentions from outside of the parish because we received so few of them. Today, the parish books Masses six months out. What does this mean? If you send in a Mass intention on October 24<sup>th</sup> asking for a Mass in December, you are way *TOO LATE!!* A Mass intention received on October 24<sup>th</sup> will most likely be celebrated sometime next April or May!! Remember, the efficacy of a Mass being celebrated for a loved one is not contingent upon it falling on the exact date you request! The important and noble thing is that we have Masses celebrated for the repose of the souls of our loved ones commending them to the mercy of God. If you do have a specific date, sending it in 6-12 months in advance will increase the likelihood that we will be able to book it for the date specified.

On November 2<sup>nd</sup> we will celebrate the Commemoration of the Souls of all the Faithful departed. All Souls Masses are offered collectively for the intentions

received via the offertory envelope for November 2<sup>nd</sup> or the All Souls envelopes available at the entryway of Church. If the total offering received for All Souls is \$100, then the parish will offer 10 Masses in the coming year collectively for all the souls listed on the offering envelopes. Yes, I do read the names as we receive them! Yes, before each Mass offered for All Souls I think of all the people collectively! As we approach All Hallows Eve, more than a day

to Trick or Treat, it is a day to celebrate the heroic virtues of the holy men and women of every time and place who have left us the great testimony of a faith filled life! More than a day to be frightened by deathly things, it is a day to pray for the repose of all souls, that through the mercy of God they may rest in peace!
