

#### **INCLEMENT WEATHER**



On this coming Saturday, we celebrate as Catholics and Christians, what has long been a day of great mourning: The Anniversary of Roe. Vs. Wade. In recent years, for the first time in the history of the Pro-Life March for Life that takes place annually in Washington, D.C., we had a pro-life President and Vice President, Trump and Pence, speak at these rallies encouraging the hundreds of thousands of marchers. For all that may be said about the former administration; we must give them credit for defending the rights of the unborn and standing in solidarity with them and those who work to build the Lord's Kingdom of Life. In only a year's time, the U.S. has seen much of the progress in the pro-life cause overturned by Executives Orders from the current administration which rolled back many restrictions on the use of tax money for the purpose of promoting the end of life within the womb.

On January 22<sup>nd</sup>, we once again join ourselves in solidarity with Catholics in the United States in the Day of Prayer for the legal protection of the unborn. At the morning Mass, purple will be used for the priest as an outward sign of our need to fast, pray, and mourn the lives which have been lost and broken. Mass will continue with Adoration of the

Blessed Sacrament, giving us time to pray and will conclude with solemn Benediction at 11 am. It is a special day and an opportunity for us as a community, Ossipee and Wakefield, St. Joseph and St. Anthony, to join in solidarity with each other and the Church to pray for our nation.

As you may know, on days such as January 22<sup>nd</sup>, the Diocese inquires with parishes to see what they are offering to mark the significance of the day. A year ago, 2021, the Bishop specifically asked every parish to mark the day with a significant event. We did this on Friday, January 22, 2021 with a Mass at noon followed by several hours of adoration. The Diocese will also inquire, from time to time, about the level of parish participation in these events. It is relatively easy for the priest to add a Mass or adoration for such days, but where we struggle as a parish is to see an active participation of the people praying in solidarity with their priest, and with their fellow Catholics of N.H. So, I encourage you to take advantage of this Saturday morning to set aside the normal activities of a Saturday and to support your parish community and to witness to the sacredness of human life by joining us for Mass and prayer.
