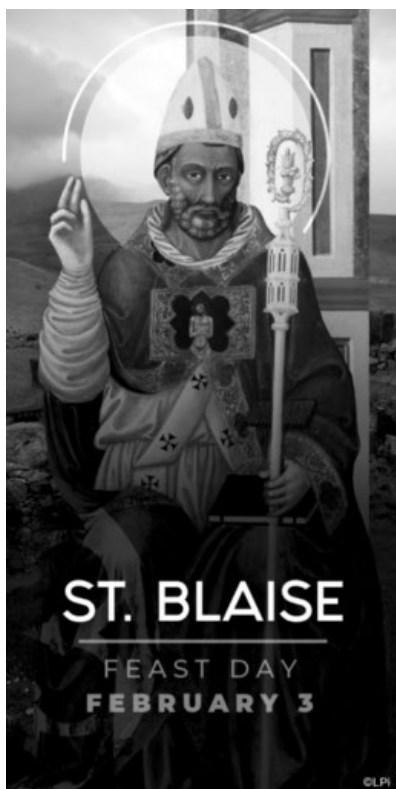

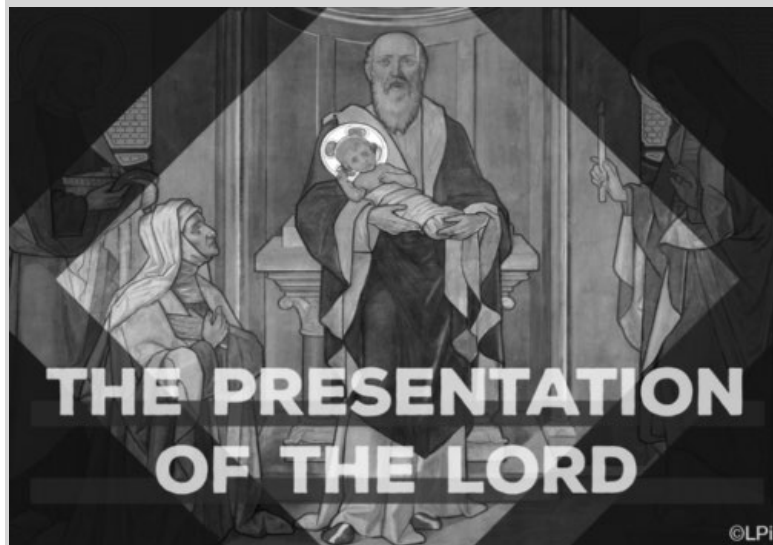

From the Pastor's Desk

Next weekend, February 5-6th, we take up our annual collection to support the parish's assessment for Diocesan Catholic Schools. I call it "our collection" because 100% of what we take in stays within the parish to help us pay one of the monthly line items on our Diocesan Assessment. Even though I teach this fundamental fiscal reality every year; people still hold to the inaccurate assumption that this is just another "second collection" that does not help the parish. Historically, the most underperformed support of any second collection in a given fiscal year for our parish is the one second collection that could benefit us the most: The Collection for Diocesan Catholic Schools!!!

As I mentioned earlier in this Fiscal Year, the formula for Diocesan Catholic Schools changed July 1st to the benefit of the majority of parishes. Unfortunately, we are in the minority! This year the Assessment for St. Anthony increased to \$545.33 a month (\$6,543.90 a year) and for St. Joseph it increased to \$478.92 a month (\$5,747.04 a year). Every cent we take in next weekend (and throughout the year we have the E-Giving option to support Catholic Schools) will help us pay this assessment!!

So, to support The Diocesan Catholic School Collection is to support St. Anthony and St. Joseph. To choose not to contribute to Catholic Schools is to choose not to support St. Anthony and St. Joseph!

For comparative purposes, these are the numbers for our second collections for Diocesan Catholic Schools over the last few years. 2018 SA \$497 SJ \$550 2019 SA \$652 SJ \$447 2020 SA \$606 SJ \$524 2021 SA \$340 SJ \$309. As you can see, we fall significantly short each year in our support of the parish's ability to pay for its Diocesan School Assessment. Regardless of how much we collect for the Diocesan Schools, we still are assessed the full amount and are expected to pay the balance of our assessment from our Sunday Offertory. As a way of understanding how important this upcoming collection is for our parish, think of it like the cost of Fuel and Snow Removal. Just as we know we need to support the parish in its ability to heat the buildings and to keep the parking lots clear so we need to support the parish in its ability to support the work of our Catholic schools. May the Lord reward us for our generosity in support of training young minds and hearts in the rich tradition of our Catholic heritage!
