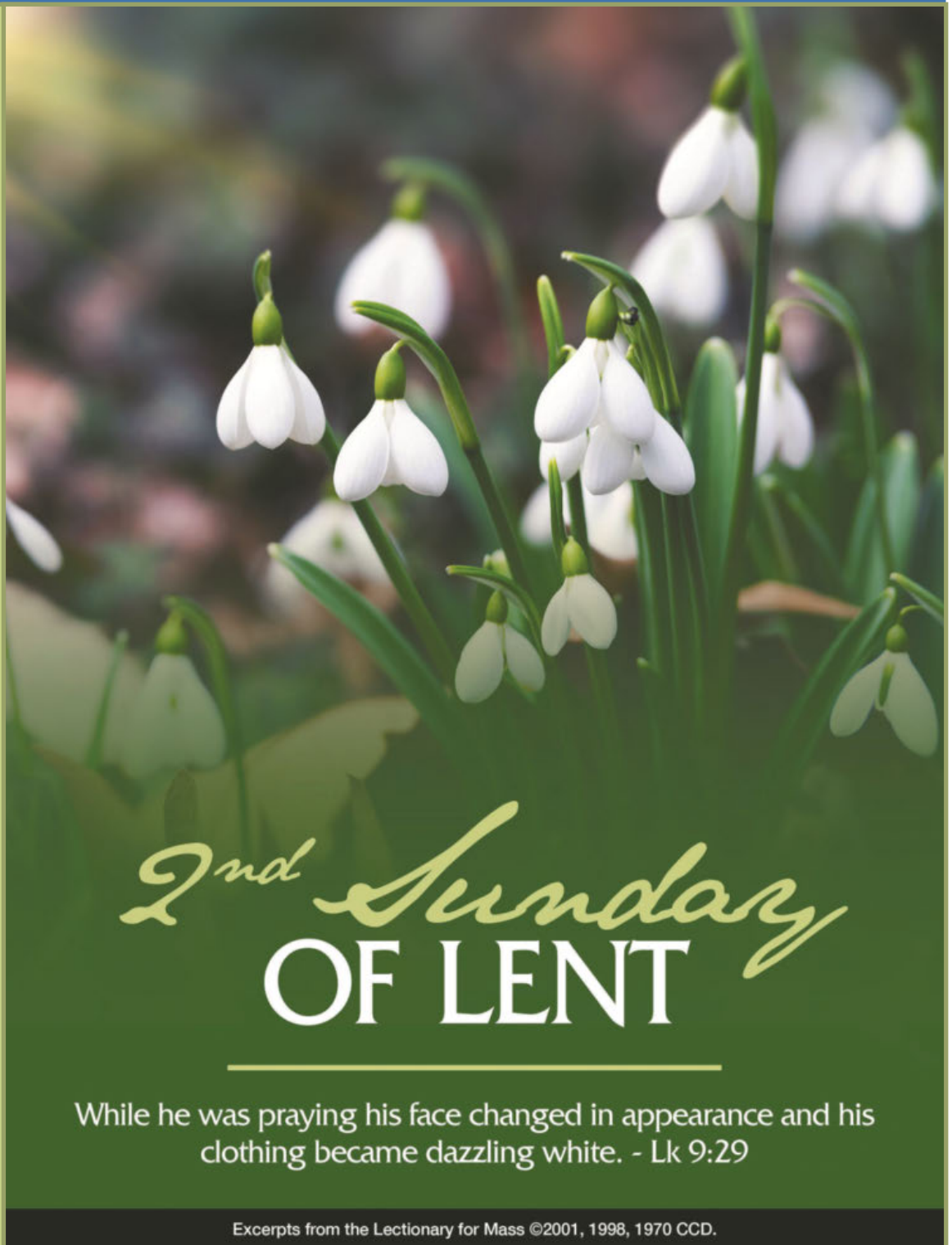

You will be called forward at the end of Mass to receive your pyx. This will assist us in knowing who our homebound parishioners are.

If you arrive after Mass begins, please sign in the book, and following Mass, ask the sacristan to place a consecrated host into your pyx.

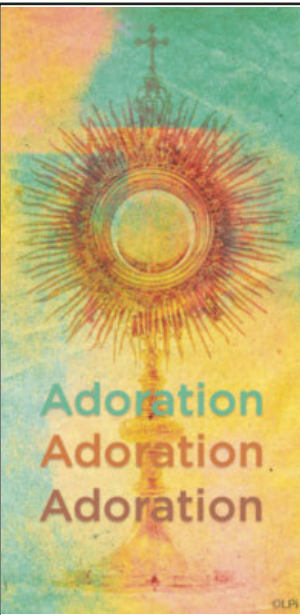

**IMPORTANT OBSERVANCES
FOR THE SEASON OF LENT**

Lent began on Ash Wednesday, March 2, and goes until the evening Mass of the Lord's Supper on Holy Thursday, April 14. During the season of Lent the Church calls all Catholics to observe the teachings below:

FAST & ABSTINENCE:

- ❖ **Ash Wednesday and Good Friday** - March 2 and April 15 are days of fast and abstinence (from meat) in the Universal Church.
- ❖ **Every Friday of Lent** - All Fridays of Lent are days of abstinence (from meat) in the Church in the United States.
- ❖ **The Law of Abstinence** - Binds Catholics aged 14 and older.
- ❖ **The Law of Fasting** - Binds Catholics aged 18 and over, until the beginning of their 60th year (through age 59).

EASTER DUTY:

According to *Code of Canon Law, 920 §1-2*, after being initiated into the Most Holy Eucharist, each of the faithful is obliged to receive Holy Communion at least once a year (§1). This precept must be fulfilled during the Easter Season unless it is fulfilled for a just cause at another time during the year. In the United States, the Easter Season is from the first Sunday of Lent to Trinity Sunday (§2).

In conjunction with Easter Duty Canon 920 is the **second precept**--"You shall confess your sins at least once a year"--which ensures preparation for the Eucharist by the reception of the Sacrament of Reconciliation, which continues Baptism's work of conversion and forgiveness (CCC 1457).

The Stations of the Cross is a Lenten devotion that offers witness to Jesus' Passion and Death. At each station we use our senses and imagination to reflect prayerfully upon Jesus' suffering, death, and resurrection and to simply experience Christ's abundant love for us.
