

Faith in Action—Faith Pilgrim Icon Program

St. Maximilian Kolbe Council #11747 Knights of Columbus will sponsor the Pilgrim Icon Prayer Service in Honor of St. Joseph. Please join us!

Tuesday, June 7 at 7:00 p.m. St. Maximilian Kolbe Church

An icon of St. Joseph which is making a worldwide tour that started with Pope Francis and sponsored by the International Order of Knights of Columbus will be the centerpiece of this special prayer service.

The prayer service, flowing from the Year of St. Joseph declared by Pope Francis in 2021, and inspired by his apostolic letter Patris Corde, strives to honor St. Joseph and pray for his intercession in preserving, cultivating and passing on the Catholic faith to future generations.

In the first year of his pontificate, Pope Francis received the Order's Board of Directors in a private audience, during which the Holy Father said, "I commend all of you in a special way to the intercession of St. Joseph, the protector of the Holy Family of Nazareth, who is an admirable model of those manly virtues of quiet strength, integrity and fidelity which the Knights of Columbus are committed to



preserving, cultivating and passing on to future generations of Catholic men."

The St. Joseph icon is the latest icon to be a part of the Knights of Columbus Pilgrim Icon Program. The icon will be on display at St. Bartholomew Church on June 12.

The Knights of Columbus, Cheverus Council #2344, have set up a relief fund for Ukraine called "The Ukraine Solidarity Fund" where 100% of all money collected goes toward the relief efforts.

The National Knights of Columbus will match the first \$500,000 collected dollar for dollar. Donations can be made by logging onto www.kofc.org OR check donations made out to Cheverus Council #2344 OR cash donations.

Cash and check donations can be dropped off at Broadway Gardens in South Portland. Thank you for any donation you can make.



Breathe new life into the world through me.










