**ST. KATERI TEKAKWITHA**

On July 14, we celebrate the feast of the "Lily of the Mohawks." St. Kateri Tekakwitha is the first Native American woman to be canonized. Orphaned by a smallpox outbreak, Kateri survived with severe scarring and impaired eyesight. Despite tragedy, she was a devout girl at a young age, often building crosses from sticks in the woods. When she was 18, she began secret instruction in the Catholic faith with French missionaries. Her commitment to Christianity and vow of virginity was misunderstood and ridiculed by her fellow villagers. She escaped to a nearby mission, where she attended daily Mass, taught the children, and cared for the sick and the elderly. Sometimes the greatest misunderstandings can come from those closest to us. Like St. Kateri, God invites us to be faithful to our commitments of faith and to always respond in love.

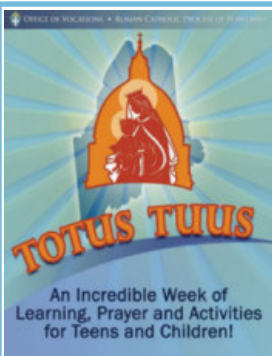

▼ **St. John Paul II Parish — For the Period ended 6/30/2023 — Parish & School Budgets** ▼

Dear Parishioners,

As we begin a new fiscal year, I would like to share with you the budget for July 1, 2022 – June 30, 2023 (FY 2023). This is an annual requirement of the Diocese and must be done at the beginning of each fiscal year.

Our world remains in a state of uncertainty, but we continue to move forward in hope. We are seeing more of our parishioners return to our pews. Through your generosity and fidelity, we have been able to bring life back to our parish and look forward to this expanding in the year to come. In August, Sophie Ritchie will be joining our staff as a full-time Assistant Faith Formation Director to lead our Middle and High School Youth Ministry programs.

As your pastor I take seriously the responsibility to be a good steward of your contributions to the parish. In cooperation with the Finance Council and our staff, we strive to present you a balanced budget each year. Our operating budget for the coming year is very tight, so we anticipate that we will be financing the much-needed capital projects through parish savings.

- † We are updating the signs at all three of our Churches, beginning with St. Bartholomew Church. We have started the design phase and we look forward to sharing more about this project soon.
- † Some repair work to the Holy Cross Church and School parking lots began in June. Over the summer, cracks will be filled and the surface re-stripped.
- † The St. Maximilian Kolbe Rectory roof is more than 20 years old and will be replaced in the next year.

We are confident that we are using parish funds – both in operations and capital expenditures – as a good investment in the future of the parish.

Thank you for your continued support of St. John Paul II Parish.

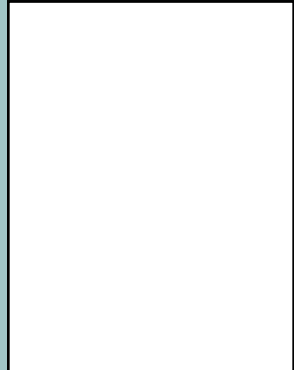

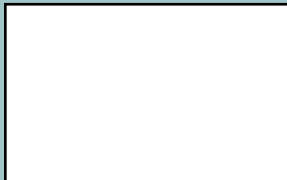
