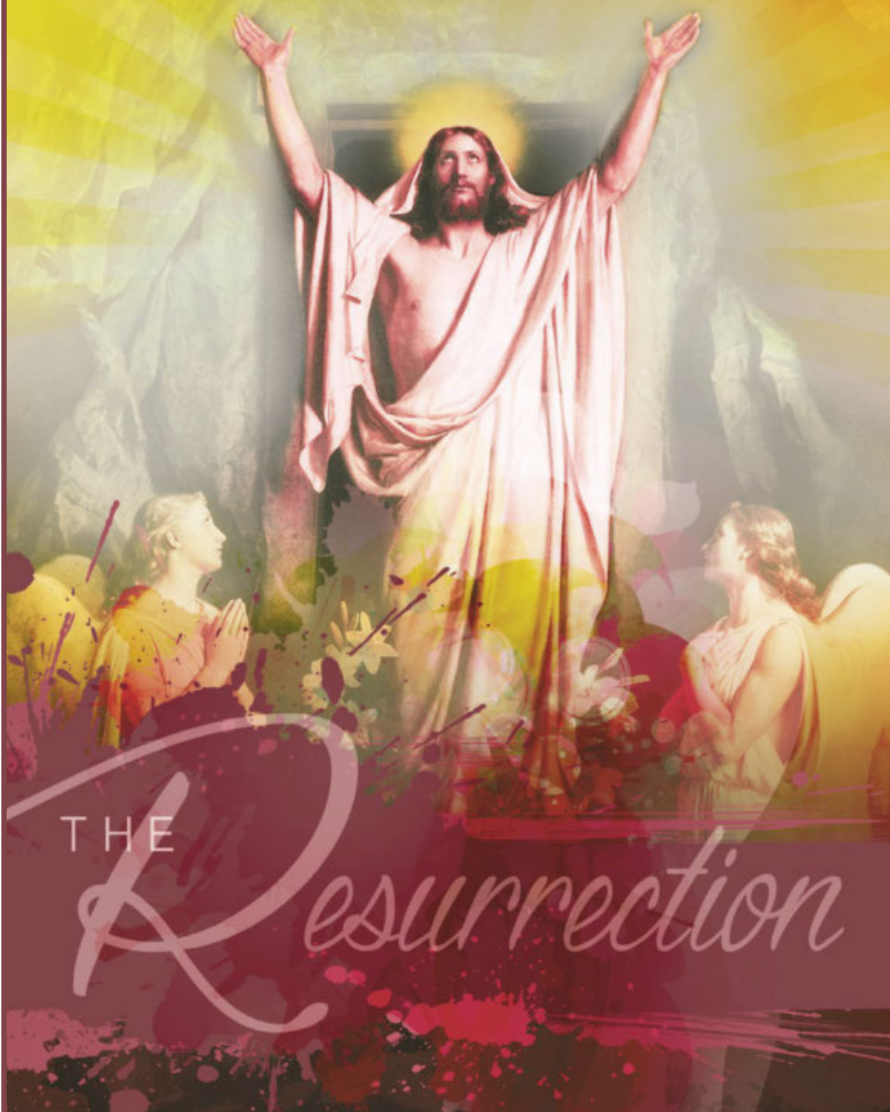

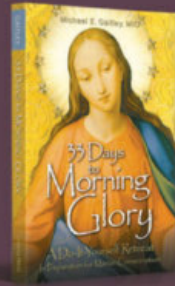

Children and Families

Our parish offers faith-filled programs for children and families. We host Monthly Family Formation Sessions, where families grow together in hands-on, engaging learning. Kindergarten and Tween drop-off programs meet twice a month with interactive activities, games, and stories rooted in Scripture and prayer. Children's Sacramental Preparation is a two-year journey of faith including retreats and family sessions. Plus, our summer Vacation Bible School brings Scripture to life through fun, faith-filled experiences for children of all ages.

Teens and Young Adults

Our parish offers opportunities for teens and young adults to grow in faith and community. Sunday evenings feature separate Youth Ministry sessions for Middle and High School students, with games, teachings, and prayer that help teens encounter God and one another. 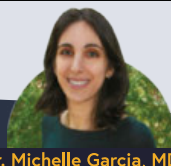
